- G 265 THOMAS ANDREWS TO WILLIAM ANDREWS  
 February 14, 1749. 20 pds. for 100 A. "...where Thomas Andrews now  
 liveth being part of one patent bearing Date the first day of March  
 Anno 1721..." At Panter Gut adj. Norfleets line on Roanoke River.  
 Wit: William Tise, Matthew Seay, Martha Andrews. February Court 1749. \*.
- G 266 FRANCES OLIVER TO JOHN OLIVER  
 August 1, 1749. Bargain. Negroe plus land. "...Frances Oliver widow  
 and Relict of Andrews Oliver late of Bertie County..." One negro  
 man named Beckwith and a certain parcel of land. "...John Oliver doth  
 bargain covenant and agree with the s'd Frances Oliver to pay all  
 Funeral Charges all Just and Lawfull Debts which was due and owing  
 from the s'd Deceased Andrew Oliver's Estate...and to pay and De-  
 liver to s'd Frances Oliver fifteen Barr'l's of Good merchantable  
 corn in the year one Thousand and Seven hundred and Fifty..." Wit:  
 Joseph Jordan, Richard Tomlinson. February Court 1749. \*.
- G 267 REBECCA PINNER...An Affadidavit  
 " Bertie County. This day came before me Rebeccah Pinner & made oath  
 that She Saw her Father John Rasberry deceased give and Deliver unto  
 John Rasberry the Son of the s'd Deceased a Certain Negro fellow  
 Called Tom but not that he Should be possessed with him till after  
 the death of the s'd Deceased & his wife. Given under my hand this  
 6th day of January 1749/50. J. Early, J.P." Wit: William Hosea,
