to the said John by Hannah his wife---". Land part of 640 A. formerly  
granted Richard Booth. On WS Chowan River "---Below the ferry Point  
so called formerly whereon Campbell now lives. Adj. John Howell.  
"Excepting ten feet Square to Thomas Sutton for Burying Ground."

- G 489 WILLIAM SOANE of Tyrill Co. TO JOHN CAMPBELL, merchant  
September 28, 1752 Bond to assure true title for 270 A. "I---Heir at  
Law to John Soanes Late of Bertie County Deceased---am firmly bound---  
in the amount of Fifty Pounds Sterling Lawfull money of England---".  
This bond to be forfeited if land title is not clear. Wit: John Hardison,  
Edward Rasor. May Court 1753. Benjamin Wynns C/C.
- G 490 WILLIAM BUSH TO HARDY BUSH  
May 8, 1730 Deed of Gift for 200 A. "---To my Loving Kinsman Hardy  
Bush Orphan Son of John Bush---Lately Deceased---". Land in Chinkopen  
Neck at the mouth of Polecatt Branch at the Gnawing Pond. Adj. Thomas  
McClendon. On Wiccacon Creek. Wit: William Cranford, John Wynns.  
May Court 1730. Thomas Hansford D. C/C.
- G 491 HARDY BUSH TO BENJAMIN WYNNS, yeoman  
July 18, 1752 12 pds. "---my Right Title and Claim to within mentioned  
Lands---". Wit: Thomas Castellow, Mary Castellow. May Court 1753.  
Benjamin Wynns C/C.
- G 492 JOSEPH PERRY TO JESSE WOOD  
July 3, 1752 25 pds. for 60 A. At Miery Branch and Deertree Branch  
adj. "s'd Perry". Wit: Benjamin Wynns, William Wynns, James Wood.  
May Court 1753. Benjamin Wynns C/C.
- G 493 MICHAEL KING TO NATHAN MIERS  
January 18, 1753 28 pds. for 72 A. Land on Broad Branch adj. John  
Williams, Jun., Samuel Herring. Wit: William King, Henry Roads, Charles  
King. May Court 1753. Benjamin Wynns C/C.
- G 495 JOHN WELLS TO RICHARD FREEMAN of Chowan Co.  
December 26, 1752 29 pds. for 225 A. Between Walter Draughan, Jonathan  
Miller and James Holley on Barbeque Swamp. Wit: John Freeman, Thomas  
Morris, James Freeman. May Court 1753. Benjamin Wynns C/C.
