Wood) the said land to be equally divided between William Duffield
& His Eldest Daughters...(therefore) I James Wood, eldest son and
heir of the s'd James Wood...do hereby release...also (by) brotherly
affection I bear to my sister Sarah...the tract of land of my
father's deed of gift..." Wit: Daniel Rogers, John Hare. May Court
