Can anyone tell me who this William Acock is? This came from Genweb archives and is on file in William Sheppard Collection at East Carolina University in Greenville, NC. It says that William Acock made a donation of 1(pound?) for help in constructing a church in Greene Co., NC along the Contentny Creek. The Church is called Little Goshen Episcopal Church built on Col. William Sheppard and Capt. John Murphrey land. It was planned in May 1770 and to be completed in May 1772. It goes on to describe the care of building it, the cost, and exact demensions as well as furnishings. I'm wondering who this William may be and where the Church was or is located.
