Issue of January 2, 1802

Married on Sunday evening, by the Rev. Mr. De Vega, Mr. Elizer Levy, of this city, to Miss Anna Abrahams, of New-Jersey. Died on Christmas day, at his residence on the Congaree, Jacob Gelger, Esq., a member of the state legislature, from Saxe Gotha district.

Issue of January 4, 1802

Married, on the 24th ult., in the parish of St. James, Santee, by the Rev. Dr. Fraser, Mr. Abraham Michau, planter, to Mrs. Mary S. Duane. Married on Thursday evening, the 31st ult., by the Rev. Dr. Hollingshead, Mr. John Whitesides, to Miss Harriet Ann Anderson, both of this city. Married, on Thursday night, Joshua Player, Esq. to Miss Charlotte Elizabeth Thompson, daughter of the late Mr. James H. Thompson. Died, at his plantation near Columbia, lieut. col. William Goodwin, commandant of the 34th regiment of militia of this state. Died, on the 25th Dec. last at his plantation in Christ Church parish, Nathaniel Legare, Esq.

Issue of January 5, 1802

Married on Thursday evening, the 31st ult. by the Rev. Dr. Furman, Mr. Samuel Yates, to Miss Ann Hanahan, both of this city.

Married on Sunday evening, by the Rev. Mr. Munds, Mr. William Taylor, to Miss Elizabeth Fordyce, both of this place. Died, on Monday, the 14th of December last, at his plantation in St. Matthew's parish, universally regretted, William Healy Esq. He served for many years as representative of that parish--during the revolutionary war, in which station he was distinguished with the highest confidence of Gen. Green....

Issue of January 8, 1802

Married on Sunday evening, by the Rev. Mr. Hollingshead, Mr. Lewis Monnar, to Mrs. Mary Smith.

Married last evening, by the rev. Mr. Munds, Mr. James Cross to Miss Margaret Neek.

Died, on the 31st ult., in the 32d year of his age, Mr. Jacob Strobel(?), of Indian Field. ...

Died, on the 26th ult., in the 52d year of his age, Mr. Nicholas Silbery, a native of Sweden, and for many years an inhabitant of this city.

Died, on Pomper Neck, in St. Bartholomew's parish, Mr. John Croil, aged 73 years, upwards of 40 of which he had spent on that spot, so generally reputed to be unhealthy. He was a native of this state and sprung from a respectable family of the first settlers....

Died, on Tuesday, the 5th instant, Mrs. Christian Dawson, a native of Scotland, and relict of the late Rev. William Dawson, in the 82d year of her age, 35 of which she passed in this state and city....

Died, at Kingston in Massachusetts, Mr. Ebenezer Cobb, aged 107 years, 8 months and 6 days, having lived in three centuries.

Died on the 21st Dec. in Caroline county, Maryland, Mrs. Mary Beauchamp, at the very advanced age of 119 years.... Died at Kingston in Massachusetts, Mr. Ebenezer Cobb, aged 107 years, 8 months and 6 days...born in Plymouth, 22 March 1694...(long account)

Issue of January 13, 1802

Died on the 8th inst., after a lingering and painful sickness, in the 24th year of her age, Mrs. Mary Wall, widow of Mr. Richard Gilbert Wall, merchant.

Issue of January 15, 1802

Married, last evening, by the Rev. Dr. Keith, Archibald Scott, esq. of James Island, to Miss Elizabeth Rivers Stone, daughter of the late capt. Benjamin Stone, of James Island.

Issue of January 16, 1802

Married on Saturday the 2d instant, by the Rev. Mr. Furman, Mr. Boudet, miniature-painter and drawing master, to the amiable Miss Margaret M'Gill, both of this city.

Married, on Tuesday night, by the Rev. Mr. Hollingshead, Mr. Jonathan Cape, to Miss Letitia Roulain, daughter of Daniel Roulain, deceased, both of this city.

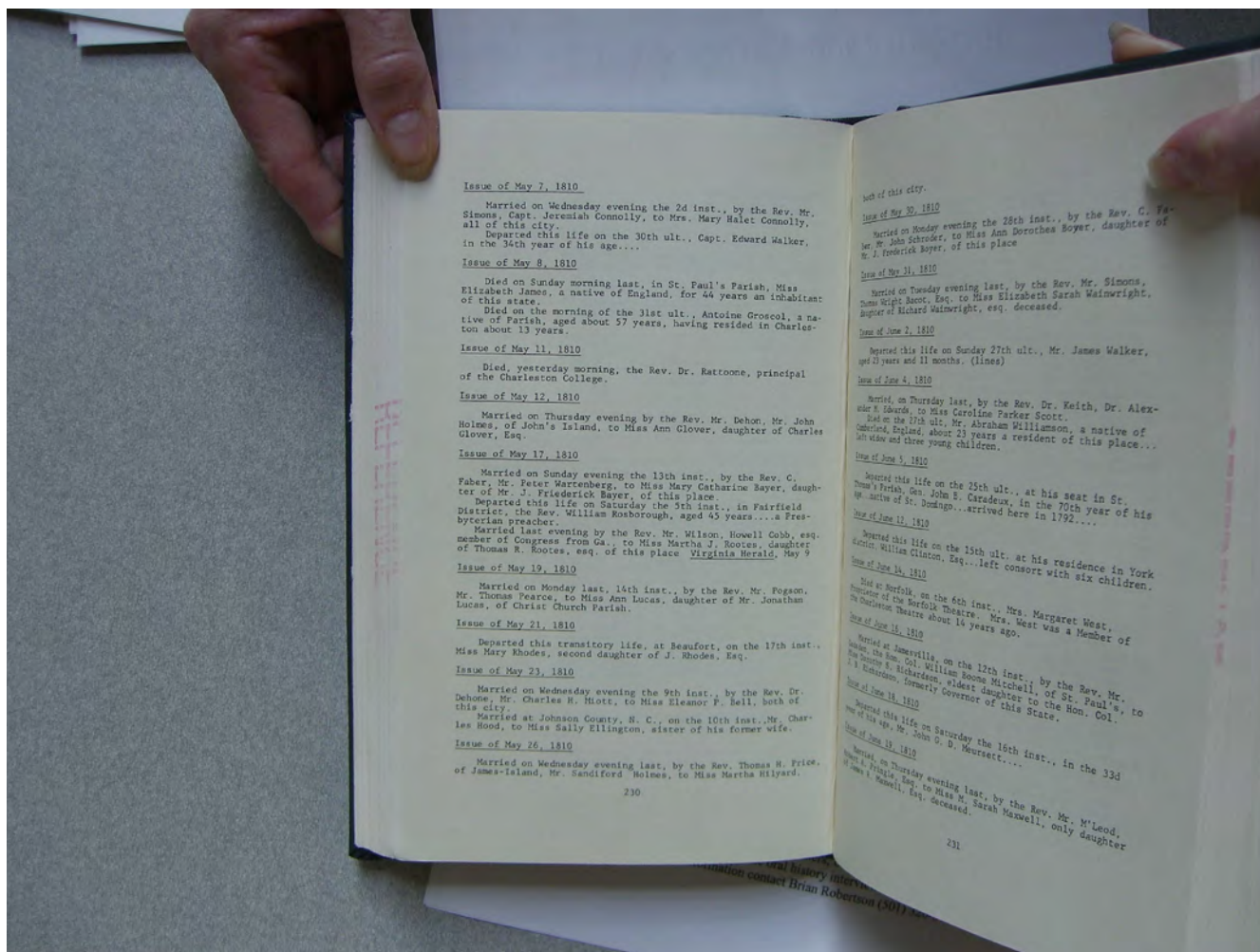
Issue of January 19, 1802
