Present Capt. Ralph Fletcher Steward: Mr. John Whitby, Mr. Joseph Suttten, Mr. Robert Wilson, Justices.

Richard Atkison commenceinge sute against Daniell Snooke, and the Jury findeinge for the Plaintiff: It is Therefore Ordered that Daniell Snooke pay unto Richard Atkison twenty-five shillings, beinge the price of the horse sued for, accordeinge to the apprizement of four men upon Oath Vizt. Caleb Callaway, Richard Evins, John Lilly, and John Spelman: with Costs.

Stephen Mannoringe commenceinge sute against David Blake, as Attorney to Edward Norwood, and Stephen Mannoringe not proveinge himselfe Norwoods Attorney, and also makeinge double plea in his declaration It is therefore Ordered that David Blake have a nonsute, against Stephen Mannoringe, and that Stephen Mannoringe pay costs.

Richard Dorman enters marks upon record for four children under his care of Christopher Nicholsons. August the 23th, 1691, Sarah Nicholsons marke is a cropp and a slit in each eare, the slit beinge in the under corner of the eare.

Elizabeth Nicholsons marke is a crop, a slit, and an underkeele on theright eare; and an overkeele on the left eare.

Ann Nicholsons marke is a cropp, and two slits on the right eare and an over keele, and an under keele on the left eare.

Joseph Nicholson enters his marke upon recorde August the 23th, 1691, beinge a crop and a slit in the under corner of the right eare, and the left eare whole.

John Whitby enters his marke upon recorde September the 16th 1691, being a slit downe the middle of the right eare, and a half penny on the upper, and under side of the same eare, at the root of the eare: and a cropp and two slits on the left eare, and a halfe penny on the underside therof.

(33) Joseph Suttten the Son of Nathaniell Suttten enters his marke upp(on) recorde September the 16th 1691, beinge a cropp and two slits on the left eare and a hole in the right eare.

Humphrey Burroughs enters his marke upon record March the 17th 1691/2 beinge a cropp, and a slit in each eare.

Charles Mackdaniell enters his marke upon recorde March the 19th 1691/2, being a crop and a slit on the right eare, and a hole and over keele on the left eare.
