MOSELEY, BAKER, was Master of the Brigantine JOSEPH in (1775) 1-436; his daughter MARY MOSELEY born about (1783) is said to have married (1) SAMUEL JARVIS and (2) in (1803) WILLIAM COATES BUTLER of Philadelphia; it has been suggested that he was a grandson of EDWARD MOSELEY, who came from PRINCESS ANNE COUNTY, Va to CHOWAN precinct about (1706-5) SAMUEL JARVIS who married the daughter MARY MOSELEY lived in CURRITUCK COUNTY, North Carolina, but he probably married MARY MOSELEY in PASQUOTANK 3-316. 3-317.

MOSELEY, CAPT. JOHN, vestryman of LIMEHAVEN PAR-
ISH in Princess Anne County, Va. (NORFOLK)
and Captain FRANCIS MOSELEY 1-638; JOHN
MOSELEY, who in (1719) bought lands from
DENNIS MACLENDY 1-629.

MOSS, JOSEPH, married SARAH SHACKELFORD daughter of JOHN SHACKELFORD 1-73.

MOTT, JOHN and HANNAH MOTT, of New Hanover County related to JOB HOWES Sr. and JR. mentioned in the will of SAMUEL BRIDGES (1730) perhaps 1-176.

Now, NATHAN name mentioned in deed to WILLIAM
LATTIMORE in (1716) 1-618.

MOYE, JOHN (Spelled MOY) died leaving will in CURRITUCK in (1735) mentions daughter JANE, son JOHN and grandfather PIEDERS and his wife AVIS 1-62.

WOYE, THOMAS left will in CHOWAN in (1723) and named wife ELIZABETH, sons THOMAS and JOHN, WILLIAM PHILLIPS and "my wife's daughters" ELIZABETH and PATIENCE. 1-62.

MULLEN, ABRAHAM, died in BERTIE in (1780) and left will naming sons JOSEPH, GREENBERRY & THOMAS; EDWARD TURNER and AGNES TURNER witnesses 2-347.

MILLER, JAMES left will in (1796) in which he mentions ELIZABETH CALLAWAY and her son THOMAS CALLAWAY; wife and JOHN STANTON executors; SIMON LONG, JOAB THOMPSON and LEAVEN THACH, witnesses 3-179.

MULLIN, GREENHERRY, left will in HERTIE (1811)
names wife FARIET, daughter SARAH, son WIL-
LIAM MULLIN; witnesses ELIZABETH WALSTON,
WILLIAM LEE GRAY and TURNER WALSTON 2-530.

MULLEN, JACOB, of PERQUIMANS will in (1758) and he names children ISAAC, ABRAHAM, JACOB and THOMAS MULLEN, daughter HANNAH 1-60.

MULLEN, PATSY, was the daughter of SARAH TURNER who left will (1827) and the wife of JOSEPH TURNER 3-354.

MULLEN, ZADOCK left will (1813) names wife HANCOCK
son BENJAMIN MULLEN, daughter MARY GODFREY
and son ASHER MULLEN and others 3-342.

LUMFORD, LEBORRAH, married JOHN RUSSELL, the son of GEORGE RUSSELL of COUNTY KENT, England in (1679) by the Rev. GORDON 3-201.

MUMFORD, JOSEPH, of ONSLOW POINT, left will not dated (GRIME p. 260 says 1732) wife ANN and daughter ELIZABETH and sons JOSEPH and EDWARD. Executors EDWARD HOWARD and THOMAS FULLARD; JAMES MURRAY, EDWARD HOWARD and ELIZABETH MURRAY witnesses 1-62 and GRIMES p. 260.

MUNDAY, ALICE, in (1716) with JOHN ODGM witnessed Power of Attorney from WILLIAM DOWNING to WILLIAM SHAPPE, relating to a sale made by one MACLENDEN. 1-293.

MUNDEN, WILLIAM left will in (1793) wife HANNAH
and children named 3-179.

MUNDEN, ELISHA left will in (1821) wife NANCY & children, including CHRISTOPHER and JOHN MUNDEN 2-343.

MUNDS, JOSEPH, will (1832) wife HANNAH, with JOSEPH WHITE a witness 3-343.

MARKS FAMILY. PETER MARKS of "Ye Little Creeke" (will 1656) in Lower Norfolk Virginia, was the ancestor of JOHN MARKS of 1706 (1-35) and THOMAS MARKS of 1702 (1-6, 2-456, who acquired lands on ROCKHOCK CREEK, as shown by this record. He was the father of STEPHEN who died in ANNEUNDO COUNTY, Virginia in 1670, who left sons STEPHEN and JOHN, and the latter was the ancestors of numerous sons, including the JOHN and THOMAS who about 1700 settled in MARLE PRECINCT; also of JOHN, PETER and HASTINGS MARKS who migrated up the RAPPAHANNOCK to S SYLVANIA and HAROVER COUNTY, and from there "spread out". In 1734 "JOHN MARKS, Planter, of S PARISE, Spottsylvania County, on the South side of the RAPIDAN had wife MARY and a daughter M. In 1733 "PETER MARKS was licensed to keep an ORDINARY at the Courthouse in HAROVER COUNTY, Vi with one THOMAS PROSSER his bondsman. (1 Crozier's County Records, and W. 4 M. Mag 1912 p. 51 was the same house of entertainment, which many years later, was presided over by one JOHN SE whose daughter married PATRICK HENRY. "JOHN MARKS, planter" of St. Mark's Parish, had a son MARKS, who settled at SHEPHERDSTOWN, Virginia, up around HARPER'S FERRY, and married ELIZABETH sister of WGN. JOHN MORROW, member of Congress from that District, long years later, and a distinguished Colonel in the American Revolution. JOHN MARKS, of Shepherdstown, was also a revolt soldier, and the builder, it is claimed of the first Presbyterian Church in Fredericksburg Vi where he removed some years prior to his death, about 1812.
