X MOSELEY, EDWARD, appointed (about 1704) a Deputy to represent the heirs of JOHN LORD GRAN -VILLE, and is directed to take charge as COL OMEL of all the Regiments in the Province of NORTH CAROLINA 3-258, 3-258; EDWARD MOSKLEY did not appear in the Province until about the time of GOV, HENDERSON WALKER'S death in (1704), and his Commission must have been issued about the time of the CARY REBELLION 3-259; he married the widow of GOV. THOMAS CART 1-294; in(1737) EDWARD MOSELSY was a trustee for WILLIAM ROW-DEN and CHARLES WESBRAR in a deed to DR. FETER MARKS of "Ye Little Creeke" (will 1656) in Lower Borfolk Virginia, was the ancestor of JOHN MARKS of 1706 (1-35) and THOMAS MARKS of 1702 (1-6, 2-456, who acquired lands on HOCKHOCK CREEK, as shown by this record. He was the father of STERE! who died in ANSELDND COUNTY, Virginia in 1670, who left sone STEPHEN and JOHN, and the latter were the ancestors of numerous sons, including the JOHN and THOMAS who about 1700 settled in . HARLE PRECIECT; also of JOHN, PETER and HASTINGS MAKES who migrated up the RAPPAHARMOCK to 5 SYLVANIA and HANOVER COUNTY, and from there "spread out". In 1734 "JOHN MARKS, Flanter, of S. PARISH, Spottsylvania County, on the South side of the RAPIDAN had wife MARY and a daughter M in 1733 "PETER MARKS was licensed to keep an ORDINARY at the Courthouse in FANOVER COURTY, Vi with one THOMAS PROSSER his bondsman. (1 Crozier's County Records, and W. & M. Mag 1912 p. 5 was the same house of entertainment, which many years later, was presided over by one JURN SE whose daughter married PATRICE HEMRY. "JOHN MARKS, planter" of St. Mark's Parish, had a son MARKS, who settled at SHEPHERDSTOWN, Virginia, up around HARPER'S FERRY, and married ELLEGER sister of HCN. JOHN MORROW, member of Congress from that District, long years later, and a di guished Colonel in the American Revolution. JOHN MARKS, of Shepherdstown, vas also a revolut soldier, and the builder, it is claimed of the first Presbyterian Church in Fredericksburg Vi where he removed some years prior to his death, about 1812.
