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FOREWORD

A brief history of the formation of Bertie Precinct is necessary background for an understanding of the importance of these early Bertie County records to North Carolina history.

While Bertie Precinct was not formed until 1722, the area had long been settled. The earliest known settler in North Carolina, Nathaniel Batts, lived here as early as 1657. Documentary evidence of this is the map prepared in 1657 by Nicholas Comberford, London map maker. This map shows a house, labeled "Batts House", on the neck of land between the mouth of the Roanoke River and Salmon Creek.⁽¹⁾ In 1707 Robert Lawrence of Isle of Wight County, Virginia testified that in 1660/61 he "seated" and occupied for seven years a plantation on the southwest side of the Chowan River "three or four miles from the mouth of the Moratuck".⁽²⁾ Certainly in the 1660's there were other settlers in what is now Bertie County.

By 1722 the area was so densely populated that an act was passed to establish a separate precinct: "...that part of Albemarle County lying on the west side of Chowan River to be a precinct, bounded to the Northward by the line dividing this Government from Virginia, and the Southward by Albemarle Sound and Morattuck (Roanoke) River as far up as Welch's Creek, and then including both sides of said River, and the Branches thereof, as far as the limits of this Government...."⁽³⁾

An explanation of the formation of the counties in North Carolina is not within the scope of such a sketch as this, but brief enumeration will illustrate that many northern and central counties now in North Carolina were, in 1722-25, a part of Bertie Precinct. Tyrrell County was formed in part from Bertie in 1729. Edgecombe and Northampton counties were formed from Bertie in 1741. Later Granville (1746), Halifax (1758), Nash (1777), and Wilson (1855) counties were formed in part or in whole from Edgecombe. Hertford County was formed in part from Bertie in 1759. Martin County was formed from Halifax and Tyrrell in 1774. Washington County was formed from Tyrrell in 1799. Orange (1752), Vance (1881) were formed in part or in whole from Granville. Franklin (1779) and Warren (1779) counties were formed from Bute.⁽⁴⁾

Deed Book A is the earliest deed book in the county. An excerpt, quoted below, indicates that the first three books were combined into this one book in 1796:

A, 99. "February Court 1796. It was ordred that Stephen Outerbridge, Francis Pugh, and Jonathan Jacocks go to (the) Register's office & examine the state of the records kept therein....(signed George Gray, Clerk of Court)...Agreeable to the (amendment) ordered we called at the Register's Office and Examined the books in the same, and it appeared to us that the whole of the first three books, A,B,C, ought to be new copied in a New Book of Books....our direction is that the said Register proceed in the above manner given- under our hands and seal this sixth day of April Anno 1796." (signed)

SPELLING: There has been no attempt to edit these deeds. All proper names throughout have been copied exactly from the original deed book. Only the word patent has been given consistent spelling. See EXPLANATION on page iii for codes covering spelling.

DATES: Prior to 1752 England used the Julian Calendar, which began the first of each year on March 25th. Other European countries used the Gregorian Calendar, which begins each year on January 1st.⁽⁵⁾ Therefore, between January 1st and March 25th, double dates are often given. Sometimes a deed appears to have been recorded a year before its execution. This is merely a reflection of the difference in dates acceptable at the time. All dates have been copied exactly from the original deed book. Many deeds throughout were recorded prior to the 1722 formation of Bertie Precinct. These were recorded in what was then Chowan Precinct of Albemarle County.

This book is the first of a series of abstracts of early Bertie County Documents. As others are prepared, they will be published. (M.B.B.)

Dates: All dates are copied exactly from the original deed book. See FOREWORD for explanation of double dates. All deeds prior to the formation of Bertie Precinct in 1722 are recorded "Chowan Precinct of Albemarle County".

Spelling: All spelling except the word patent is copied exactly from the original.

Place Designations: Unless otherwise indicated, the persons in the deeds are residents of Bertie Precinct. In the original deeds the terms "Chowan Precinct of Albemarle County" and "Bertie Precinct of Albemarle County" are used almost interchangeably to indicate Bertie Precinct (now Bertie County).

+Money: In this volume the abbreviation lbs is used for pounds. In subsequent volumes pds will be used to indicate pounds. Sometimes the purchase is expressed "pounds Sterling of Great Britain"; sometimes it is "pounds of the colony of Virginia"; sometimes "pounds of this province".
