Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my son, Calvin Aycock one hundred dollars

Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto my son Gabriel Aycock the tract of land I purchased of Simon Aycock for adjoining the lands of Haron Aycock John S Barnes and others containing one hundred and thirty eight acres more or less, also one negro boy by the name of Larkin my Black-Smith tools his choice, horse bridle and saddle and his choice feather bed,stead and furniture

Item 3rd I give and bequeath my daughter Lydia Saper widow of John Saper and one negro girl by the name of Saper and fifty dollars in money to be paid out of the first that come into hands of my executor

Item 4th I lend unto my daughter Olive Hooks wife of Hardy Hooks during her natural life one negro girl by the name of Renny and at her death if she should have issue leaving her surviving said negro girl and her increase from the publication of this will be equally divided between them

and should the said Olin die leaving no issue then and in that case said sum and her increase as above to be equally divided between my children viz Barnes Aycock, Simon Aycock, Healthy Copeland and Patience Pearce.

Item 5th

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Betsy Webb fifty dollars

Item 6th

I give and bequeath unto my two grand-daughters Susan and Kelly Webb twenty dollars each


It is my will and desire that the residue of my property be sold and after paying off all my just debts and above named legacies to be equally divided together notes and accounts

between my four children viz Barnes Aycock, Simon Aycock, Healthy Copeland and Patience Pearce

And I hereby constitute and appoint my trusty sons Barnes & Simon Aycock sole executors to this my last will and testament to execute the same in every part and clause

to the true intents thereof hereby revoking and declaring utterly null and void all other wills by me at any time heretofore made
