Account of sale of lands by Robt. Joyner, guardian to the orphans of said decd., Jan. 16, 1828. A receipt was given to said guardian for the proceeds by Jno. Parker, admr. for William Parker, decd., Feb. 27, 1828, Feb. Ct. 1828. Account current with the admr. began Nov. 29, 1827. Supplies were purchased for the widow, May Ct. 1832.

PEARCE (PEERCE), BRYAN, account of sale held by Willis Bradley, admr., Nov. 14, 1834. The widow bought two of the seven articles. Account current with the admr. and audit and settlement of account, May Ct. 1837.

PEELE (PEEL), JOHN, account current with Hillary Peele, exr., began at Aug. Ct. 1818. Lucy Peele was a legatee. Audit and settlement of estate and division of the money arising from the estate among John Peele; George Moore in right of his wife, Elizabeth; Robert Ruffin in right of his wife, Rachel; Pherabe Peele; Peggy Peele; and Richard Peele, May Ct. 1820. Account of sale of property held after the death of his wife, Lucey Peel, sold Aug. 19, 1820, Feb. Ct. 1822. Account current with Hillary Peele, exr. of John Peele, decd., in regard to that part of the estate lent to his wife, Lucey Peele. Audit and settlement of account and division of money among the six legal heirs, not named, Feb. Ct. 1822.

Nov. 1824. Audit and settlement of account, Dec. 29, 1826, Feb. Ct. 1827.

PENDER, CELIA, inventory taken by Spencer L. Hart, exr., Aug. 1, 1821, Nov. Ct. 1821. Accounts of sales held Aug. 3 and Nov. 9, 1821. James Pender was a buyer, Nov. Ct. 1821. Account current with the exr. and audit and settlement of account, May Ct. 1824.

PENDER, DAVID, account of sale held Dec. 8, 1825. Drew Pender was the principal buyer and R. B., David, and Solomon Pender bought, Feb. Ct. 1826. Account current with Drewry Pender, admr., and audit and settlement of account, Feb. Ct. 1828.

PENDER, DAVID, account of sale held at the dwelling house of James Pender, Sept. 25, 1834. James Pender bought nearly everything, May Ct. 1835. Account current with James Pender, admr., and audit and settlement of account, Feb. Ct. 1836.

PENDER, ELIZABETH, account current with Drew Pender, admr. Audit and settlement of account, Nov. 17, 1838 (Nov. Ct. 1838).

PENDER, JOHN, account of sale of the property lent to his wife, Nancy Pender, during her lifetime and sold Oct. 1, 1822 by Sol. Pender and C. W. Knight, exrs. Martha Pender was the principal buyer and Solomon, Polley, and William Pender and Willis Drawhorn were the only other buyers, Nov. Ct. 1822. Account current with Solomon Pender and Charles W. Knight, exrs., and audit and settlement of account, Feb. Ct. 1824.

PENDER, JOSEPH, examination of the accounts of John Wilkinson, decd., former guardian to the orphans of Joseph Pender, decd. The orphans were Joseph Pender, Julia Pender, and Louisanna Pender. Spencer L.
