"Townsend Family, CS71 U 551904 - Underhill & Townsend Families by I.T. Smith." Leedocisha Townsend, from Normany in 1100 to England, married daughter of de Naville, took name of Townsend down through Adm. Roger Townsend until immigration to United States in 1630-35 from Norfolk, England. Among descendants of Gov. Alonzo B. Cornell of Ithaca, son of Ezra Cornell, founder of University. All American Townsends are allied - descendants of Adm. Roger Townsend.
