Thomas COMMANDER being heir of James TOOK & John SYMONS being heir of Thomas SYMONS, do for good causes ... set an old Negroe named Tony free from us once having some sort of Claim to him but ... forever do quit & discharge the sd Tony from our Service or our heirs to the ninetieth year of his age we hereby obliging ourselves or our heirs to forfeit the just sum of fore score pounds sterling money of old England if we the sd COMMANDER & SYMONS should pretend to make Servant of the sd Tony ... to the sd Negroe Tony. ... Signed: Thos. COMMANDER, John SYMONS. Wit: Robert HOSEA, James IN NEWBY his mark, John X BELLMAN his mark. Regt: 29 August 1720.
