Each of them bargains, sells (etc) unto the other...every his moiety or one half part of his lands, Tenements, Goods, Chattets & all other Estate both Real & Personal...Copartnership to continue during their Natural Lives...sharing all Benefits & advantages as well as losses & debts; all charges which arise either in house keeping, clothing Diet or in any other manner...If either of them should depart this life, then the heirs of him so dying shall have the one moiety or half part of all such lands, etc... If both parties shall Jointly agree to Cease this Copartnership & to divide what shall be then between them aforesaid & if either of them shall be minded to dispose of his part...then that party so selling is bound & obliged to offer the sale to the other of them, but if he should refuse to buy it, then he is hereby at liberty to sell to whom he pleases...Each being boundin the Penal sum of fifty Pounds Sterling...
