Lawful command or shall steal or proline any of his sd Masters Er.? goods or shall buy, sell or barter with any person or persons without his sd Masters Licence or any other ways within the term of ten years four months five days shall anyways mis-behave himself then this Obligation to be void & of none Effect & the sd. Negro Toney to be & remain the sd. LILLINGTONS Slave for Ever, any thing in this Writing agreement not withstanding to the true performance of the aforesd.
