(p.392) 1 May 1751.... John Winborn and wife, Phoebe Winborn, of the upper parish of Nansemond County to Joseph Holland, son of Henry Holland, decd..... 75 acres on the south side of Kingsale Swamp adjoining Mr. Isaac Fleming.

Wit: Henry Holland, Robert Holland and Job Holland.

Mary Whitfield and Jordan Chapman were said

William Smith of Newport Parish to William Glover of the same.... 225 acres being an island on Pagan Point Bay, (being part of a patent granted William Smith as Son and Heir of the aforesaid William Smith, decd., and from him it descended to his Son and Heir the present William Smith).

Mention is made of a patent of George Anderson dated 25 Oct 1695 who sold it to Ralph Vickers.
