Division of estate Nov. 6, 1784, among (1) William Scott, (2) Nancy Parker, (3) Susannah Scott, and (4) Mary Scott.

Account current with the surviving exr., Jan. 20, 1774, mentioning equal sums of money paid to Margaret Seay, James Seay, and "for his wife's part." Division of lands July 30, 1793 into two shares: (1) to Isaac Seay's representatives - land at the mouth of Great Branch adj. the Spring Bottom, Elisha Harrell, Joel Brown, Cushy Branch, and the Mill Branch, and (2) to James Seay - three tracts, the first where James Seay, dec'd., formerly lived, the second being part of a tract bought of Elisha Harrell adj. Isaac Seay, and the third being a part of a tract bought of Jesse Harrell. Receipt (Nov. 21, 1796) signed by James Seay for his share "of my deceast father James Seay's estate."

## (582) JACOB SHARP

Additional inventory Feb., 1749 by Peter Evans. Account of sale (undated) by Peter Evans (very faded), noting money paid to Thomas Barker and John Salter, and cash held in favor of the orphan, and money paid for costs of dividing the estate agreeable to the will. Division of estate, 1750, between (1) Starkey Sharp - who received Negroes George, Beck, and Hannah, and (2) Richard Figures, who
