A lovely New Year Day. Barbara cooked breakfast and went to her work lesson. I washed, tried to renovate the sleeves in my temple dress to no avail — refracted the fudge, a biscuit and jelly it seems.

I finished last year's journal and listed items of import (?) for the year.

I have given consideration to New Year's Resolutions. Certainly there a number I'd like to make but I hesitate for fear I won't keep them. Here goes:

1. Write memos re mama & papa.
2. Appeal to my four sisters to do likewise and get it together in a printed form.
3. Fast for specific purposes — invitation re certain people/incidents, etc — which trouble me.
4. Continue reading the scriptures daily — rather than five days a week.
5. Continue 1 mile exercise/day.
6. Make an effort to do a kindness each day.

1 January 1979. Tuesday

I went to a session in the temple. So Honolulu to pick up Julia Carter. She had gotten a cold on the mainland.

Barbara Smith got a job in the library.

Worked in the temple. From 4:00 — 8:00. Drove

Letter from Lettie Willmore. Roger Smith did visit them Christmas Eve.

I did a little research re spirituality. Stephen R. Covey's book Spiritual Roots --- has an excellent chapter for returned missionaries — or anyone.

Lovely weather/day while the mainland seems to be having very cold weather.

3 Jan 1979 - Wednesday

It was a struggle to get out of bed. I did my jogging outside. Back on my scripture reading. To school and finished my journal and last calendar. I think I'm ready for Jan. 8th. I did a little research in the library in the Senior Workshop.

The semester in Hawaii students are here. It was a beautiful day for them. Robert Hatch, David's friend, came. Barbara was about as excited as if he were her long friend!

4 Jan 1979, Thursday

A pleasant day in Honolulu. I made a tape to Vikar Pope going and coming. It worked out well. I was concerned that the roar of the motor might be heard or that I'd find it difficult to drive and keep my thoughts coherent.

I pursued the Health Ed films at the Health Dept. after I'd looked and copied the ones I felt were related. She gave me a catalogue. I also checked the films at the Honolulu library. I dropped (?) Liberty House, David & Maria & McDermott - nothing appealed. Had lunch at Alameda's buffet on the 30th floor.

Beverly & Warner Otley's baby died - crib death. He was excommunicated from the Church a few weeks ago - two blows so close seem a great trial for them.

5 Jan 1979, Friday

Such good nights to sleep. To school for orientation. A nice looking group of semester in Hawaii students. Worked on the slide presentation for Exterior Design. Slow - I'm not as knowledgeable about the steps of architecture as I'd like to be.

I had lunch with Joan Bennett - guests of PCC - we discussed the single women in the church. She gave me another concern/problem of singles which I hadn't thought about: fear.

Janet Jensen, Joan Bennett and I went to the Symphony. Joan drove. Her car is "meat" - tape deck - comfortable ride. Visiting conductor and Carlos Montoya

the guitarist — excellent. The orchestra's last number was Beethoven's 5th — I'm familiar with it! I went Barbara home.

6/29/79, Saturday

Janet Jensen and I went hiking on the Hauula Loop Trail — 2 1/2 miles. Janet had had trail boots. I hope to be able to go with her again. Either she was being kind or she likes about my speed. It was very pleasant. She's an interesting person.

I did my washing. We got a tape from ^{the} new + Sheron Smith family. David + Bryan and Wendell talked as well as new + Sheron. Reed Wellman talked also. Roger (their son) did stop in Utah. It was thrilling to hear about it. Tolmost had to shed a tear when Sheron spoke of how much he enjoyed it and of Doug Suggs's dream re Roger appearing. All their children were together except Barbara, Pam and Steven. I am happy for them.

Thanks to Barbara Gullett for the loan of her typewriter I typed my handout for Keneche Staker's Women's Conference on the 13th.

Java Edwards came home. Barbara, Jerry Comit and Robert Hatch went to meet her. They came home and went on a picnic.

Vivian Halverson and her dad came over. She brought me two books. It's difficult to carry on a conversation for too long because Harvey doesn't hear too well. He's a nice man.

I didn't mention that I received Carlene Hawkins's Christmas gift yesterday.

7/1 Jan 1979, Sunday

A cozy morning to sleep. Only three in the Teacher Development class. I called Laura Johnson and Sam Kanoe. They were both nice. Chad Kelisiki did such a nice job in his micro teaching. I got the film strip projector for next week. The first one didn't work. I went back for another and looked at Johnny Lings. I am toying with the idea of using it for the Social Relations lesson on Improving Your Image.

Wrote to Gladys and Adlene and Nancy + Sallie.

I fasted — without water and aldactazide. I'm glad. We had a nice fast and testimony meeting. One person said he? she? tried to give back to the church all she (he?) (a part) received. Percy Selare spoke of his esteem for the United States. That he "burned" when students criticized. After standing it as long as he can he suggests that no one is keeping them here — to go home. I don't know why it is so difficult for me to bear my testimony.

I made some blonde brownies — delivered a few to the neighbors.

Lillian Neel's niece and two friends came by. She isn't the shy girl Lillian seemed to imply.

8 January 1979 - Monday

Met three of my classes and went to David Payman's 19th century English literature class. Very small.

Waiting list for Interior Design. I spent a lot of time studying Historic Homes. Don't feel too abashed re the subject.

Vivian Lwa, Joan Bennett and Julia Carter came for family home evening. Each shared three accomplishments of 1978 — also two resolves. Very pleasant.

Grace Morse called. She's ready to come home. Will arrive on the 11th.

9 January 1979, Tuesday.

I feel I got a better start in the Food Preparation class.

Rec'd money from Prudome. It is to be counted on 1978 income. I'll be paying more taxes I expect. I don't feel I can swing a \$10,000 investment. Maybe for 6 months — 3.77 —

Go to the temple. A relatively quiet night. Paim Lowe told me re Beverly & Warren Otley's baby's death. Sad.

Came home after the temple to hear the last five minutes of Blyth-H and Simon Fraser basketball game. Was tied and they had an overtime. We lost.

10 January Wed

a tape from Vivian & Clive. Christmas gift —

"My Dawn on Earth".

We did our visiting teaching. A good feeling.

A letter from Shirley Olson. A lovely young woman.

11 Jan 1979 - Thursday

Cool, rainy day. No classes except the literature class which I'm sitting in on since I'm not having lab this week. Pat lots done. Even started cleaning out the finance file, fall grades in book, etc.

I met Grace Mose at the airport. She was late but pleased to be home.

Talked to the local Savings & Loan company re the \$10,000 investment. Decided not to take the amt I needed out of my Credit Union.

12 Jan 1979 Friday.

Havent "reached" my 200 class.

Maria J. Ashton was our Devotional Speaker. Rapph Rodgers sang the solo in the choral presentation of "I Need Thee Every Hour". Bro. Ashton spoke re the scripture where the Savior went to the Mt. of Olives - emphasized the went - a message to us. That he went early and again. All people came to him. He sat and taught them.

Called the Credit Union - changed mind re the loan investment.

Started reading assignment 1 for finance. Read the first ten. Interesting: one convert, in Dec '78. One whose family has had grave financial problems.

So Leadership (Relief Society) meeting. I'm getting a little nervous about the Kenosha State Women's Conference.

13 Jan 1979, Saturday

So Kenosha. My first section was quite well attended but I didn't feel very good about it. I did most of the talking. Sister Emma Shayne popped in toward the last. She said she liked what I said about happiness not being a matter of being married - Single people can be happy so can married. Getting married doesn't guarantee happiness. She mentioned that she still meets/lunches with former general board members - 4 married, 4 single. They have all things in common - only difference married ones have husbands. I used this as a beginning in the afternoon. It

went much better. They talked. A former student was there. I couldn't remember her name. Just returned from a mission to El Salvador. One lady, a divorcee ~~litter~~ defied me to talk about service. She felt she'd ruined her health from too much service. Even so I still felt this session was more successful than the morning.

I attended the LPS Social Service section. I felt I got a better insight of their role in the church. I also attended Seipe Larkin's on Music Appreciation.

After the conference I went to Kaula with every intention of spending my \$30 in Christmas gift certificates on a purse. Couldn't find one. Dorothy shopped & came home. Barbara & Zova were at a movie.

I also scrounged Kanohe & Kaula libraries for give away magazines. Did get some "Better Homes & Gardens" for the Interior Design class. I got several books from the library on historic housing - I got excited reading them. Was midnight before I went to bed.

14 Jan 1979, Sunday

This morning was a good example of sleeping in too long.

All five students were here for the Teacher Development class. Bless them.

Wrote Shirley Olson - Nancy & Sallie. Vivian Nelsonson is going to send Shirley some material on music for the class she'll be teaching.

Barbara cooked dinner. It was good.

15 Jan 1979 Mon

Family Home Evening. I showed Sallie Hall's mother's Christmas card. They appreciated it too.

16 Jan 1979 Tues

We were short handed in the temple. We did double duty.

17 Jan 1979 Wed

Several late assignments in finance. First lab. I'm trying to build relationships

in this class. I'm still feeling sensitive re last semester

I was brushed. Went to bed at 8:45.

18 Jan 1979 Thurs

I have commitments to discuss time with the student body officers and one in human ward to discuss Budgeting -

Shinehah Dupala stopped by. She looks good a little animosity re Mele Walfgramm. Barbara and I gave her some books - pictures. Pamphlets.

Relief Society. Six in the Social Relations. I rather expect most of the "self-esteem" aren't suffering too much most of the time.

I was almost asleep when I picked up Barbara at 11:00 pm.

Letters from Roger Smith, Gladys B + Nancy Sallie.

I put \$10,000 in the Fed. S+L. I'm thinking of getting a safety deposit box.

19 Jan 1979 Fri

Elder Thomas Morsen spoke at Devotional. Elder Gordon B. Hinckley spoke to the faculty. He spoke of the Indian brother in India, the five branches there, his daughter on the BYU - Hawaii campus. If being in one of the five branches five years ago where they sang "God Be with You 'Til We Meet Again" - that they don't know much about doing things in the church - "Lydia - the daughter - will teach the father." He spoke of the new ward house his ward has - is building? - and he told them he felt embarrassed at their affluence. H. Brian Berlin came as I was leaving school to the opera - Salome - a nice story.

20 Jan 1979 Sat

Brian Berlin came. Breakfast with us. I went to Son Kerkuehler's funeral. It was lovely in every way - tributes, music, composure of the family. From there I went to spinna Hoe's wedding reception. It was a nice, well attended occasion. Good food.

Home to shop with Brian for Aloha shirts and

muumuu for his brother and sister, I left him at the Cultural Center for the show and went to Honolulu to hear Samuel Stagner speak at Know Your Religion.

21 Jan 1979, Sunday

Guir Bedin went to Priesthood, S.S. and Sacram. in my ward. He's very handy in the kitchen. Helped me change a bulb in the entry.

I made tapes for Wilma + family + one for Gladys + Arlene Heibers.

22 Jan 1979, Mon

I pushed Guir Bedin up at 5:00 AM - also another folder and to the Honolulu airport. A long day.

Family Home Evening with Joan Bennett giving the lesson.

Zava didn't come home from work. She worked later than she expected then went to the library. Was not aware that we'd be worried. Barbara was worried too. All was well.

She told me Sunday night about her encounter with evil spirits when she was on the beach with Robert. Also that she is working with Bp. Kim and hopefully will be partaking of the Sacrament again in February. # Sherifah Tupola relative came over again. A nice visit.

23 Jan 1979 Tues

I went through a temple session.

The 110 class was upset re their lab sheets. Sherrie Chamberlain had to go home because of a death in her family.

24 Jan 1979 Wed

The first 240 exam. The lab went rather smoothly. The Mark Charles' baby is a little better.

I went to bed early. Barbara + Zava went with dates to a double feature.

25 Jan 1979, Thurs

An announcement and a note from Eulithe Nyman. She was married in Salt Lake Dec 29, 1978. I'm not surprised. She sounds happy.

Barbara had a letter from Neva - she

Left a paper for me to read. She does have a
 pleasant handwriting - doesn't write badly
 at all. She works until 11:00 tonight. Talk
 a while for me not to wait up - go to bed
 for night.
 St. Paul Society. Gen. Bennett gave the cultural
 refinement lesson on Saturday. Much we want keep
 that again.

checked five entrance program assignments, some
 very creative ones - one came in late, a few good
 girls. I told her I wouldn't accept it. She turned in
 four - printed ones - started her pattern - she
 said I wouldn't believe her - I pointed a lot and
 out poured the thing - she had no money - money
 is hard, difficult, water in turn for a chair which never
 came. Finally a friend gave her the envelope with
 a note. Don't see - I got some accepted the assignment,
 she said it wasn't as good as she like it to be -

the private state center when I was there for their
 conference dropped in, she'd been in St. Petersburg
 museum, so returning to their English in a private
 picture in Germany, a lovely girl, she thanked me for
 my talk, said it had helped her, having just return
 ed from her mission. (I quite spoke to her in the
 temple thinking she had also been there -), you never
 know, I often bring home in hand, some interesting

Sat. Jan 27, 1979

We all slept in. I washed, hosed the windows. An aesthetic experience with a beautiful cobweb filled with drops of water. Weeded the front edges until I look down and discovered a hunk of skin hanging off my finger the size of a dime. Barbara finished. She did the back — and around the poinsettias. Bud had cut the grass Friday. I feel positively civilized.

The house is clean — each doing her assignment. Julia Carter + I drove to Kanoka - Kaulia where I stopped at the libraries + Goodwill Industry looking for magazines for Intense Design. Picked up my expenditure notebook I'd left in Kaulia a couple of weeks ago. Spent my two Liberty House Christmas gift certificates on a cologne and a purse. We also did grocery shopping. Our fridge is stuffed — our January money gone. It was nice to get out.

Looked at the "Sunset" magazines I got. Barbara came home — the movie had been canceled. I went to bed — they were still up.

Sun, Jan 28, 1979

I laid over the paper. Checked out the lesson for Teacher Development. Laura Johnson and Chad Kelikiki did their first day of student teaching. Joel Maaki was late — Latiaid wasn't there for her class — it just disappeared. He didn't want any class we looked at — called them "hard-heads". Sam Kame and John Saubiki observed. Pres. Foster got the graduation certificates.

Sheena + Rob Parker spoke at Sacramento mtg. Rob was very nervous to start with —

I wrote 13 letters — I'm almost caught up.

Robert Hitch had dinner with us.

Mon, Jan 29, 1979

???

Family home evening. Vickie Awa told a joke and Gene (Moose) laughed as she never seen her laugh before. It was fun.

Tue., Jan 30, 1979

I enjoyed my AM getting caught up in school -
A pleasant evening in the temple.

Wed., Jan 31, 1979

My lab - students - are nice. I felt the lab was
a mess - organization-wise. I appreciated Paul Z.
working with my problem(?) student.

I'm still having trouble with my left leg and
thigh. I thought last week it was from wednesday - I
guess it isn't. To bed early -

Thurs., Feb 1, 1979

My lab went much better - nice girls.
Hair cut.

A tape from Gladys Banks.

Relief Society. Very sparse attendance. A good
lesson on "Chastity" - broader than the usual. Rep. and
purity of thought and deed.

Friday 2 Feb 1979

Josh Stegner spoke at Devotional. He read - well -
his talk - I suspect he was a little nervous in front of
his own faculty - Fry Loveland, Wylie Swapp, etc. Wylie
was impressed, and it should have been a David A. McKay
lecture. Nice compliment.

The opera was "Daughter of the Regiment" - colorful,
nicely done. We celebrated Julia Cauer's birthday, five months
late, gratis of Bill Cauer. La Mancha. Good.

Vivian Helweiser has bought a condominium. She
seemed tired.

Have a mentioned that I have a painful (?) weak
left leg (behind my knee) and thigh. Julia diagnosed it as
Sciatica.

Saturday 3 Feb 1979

Laura Johnson & Chad Kelilike finished their student
teaching today. Sam Kamae and John Saulili did their first
student teaching today. They all attended praise meeting - bless
them.

Sam Kamae expressed his gratitude for the class
and the teacher in his testimony. Nice young man.

Garry Comit came to bid Barbara Aloha - He
leaves for this mission tomorrow.

Sova is continuing her days' fast until she sees the Bishops.

at 9:30 pm. I hope nothing is wrong.

Mon, 5 Feb 1979

The family tape came. I had time to listen to only a part of it before family home evening. I was touched by Emira's contribution, particularly his emotion re Rogis (Smith) reunion with his parents.

We had a faculty meeting. President Andersen shared part of his presentation (with us) to the Church Board of Education.

Barbara and David's family home evening group met here again. Barbara had made caramel popcorn.

Tues, 6 Feb 1979

A busy, busy evening in the temple. Sister Stone discussed inculcating. She is concerned about quietness and efficiency — doing the work in a manner which is pleasing to the Lord.

Late First Ward had a nicely attended session. Jackie Cherry did the work for her mother.

Wed, 7 Feb 1979

A pleasant lab. A little too much food (vegetables) — attractive plates. Dalite made lupaleu (Tongan). The students seemed responsive.

A devastating experience. I attended the David H. McKay lecture — Jay Fox — Art on a Learning Experience — Excellent. It lasted the full hour so I didn't have time for lunch. Did a little lab food shopping — then home. Dora (Edwards) and Robert — were there — in the bedroom. I asked Robert to leave. On my second time to the bedroom — he — they — were dressed. He asked if we could talk. I was so shocked I replied that I couldn't — later. He left. I didn't want to eat — I did go in and put my arm around Dora — she around me — as she sat on the bed — I told her I didn't know what to say, that I had to go to school but perhaps we could talk later. I guess it's fortunate routine demands. Lab

called, a nice group of young people. Perhaps I'm a new teacher?

I tried to call Siore him to see if Jova & Robert were there. They weren't I couldn't get him — either in class or talking to someone. (I hoped it was Jova — it wasn't.)

I told Barbara we had a crisis in our home. When we got here Jova was not here. I told her — and wept — so did she. She told me of Barbara Jova's past — not a pretty one — immoral yrs. Neither of us wanted to eat. She found a little note from Jova — that she had to get away, wouldn't be back tonight — not to worry.

I called Siore him. He was too busy to see me in the next day or so — I told ^{him} with his encouragement. Confessors, to be a Bishop's court — diabolical. I wept — he was so kind. Barbara and I wept again — bitter tears.

Barbara went to campus to look for Jova. I drove over to Payless / JDA to cool my face and eyes. To the library to transfer family tape in chronological order. Barbara came later, couldn't find them. I finished the tape and walked home. Our prayers were earnest as we retired to bed.

Thurs. 8 Feb 1979

I slept fitfully. My head aches. Barbara looks washed out too. They came home — and to work. Jova's dad called at midnight!

Lesline — made lupule for the food's class.

To Relief Society. Sheena Parker did the lesson, used some Samoan translations. Effective. I went to Loune Pukahi's mini class on left over. She made fried rice, used sesame seed oil to fry it in.

Friday 9 Feb 1979

I talked to Jova as I came home for lunch. She & Robert came about 7:30 — they parked & we drove to the airport — rainy night. Jova tried to pay me as she left —

I declined her money — a medal she offered. It was a quiet ride home. Rainy. # I forgot one of my classes!

10 Feb 1979 - Saturday

I slept the sleep of the dead, after laundry — a little house work we went to Honolulu. Barbara bought some shoes. We were both tired. Barbara went to her ward party — I read my mystery.

11 Feb 1979 - Sun

I'm concerned now about talking to the Dean of Students re Robert. # Sam Kamae and John Duilili finished their ~~working~~ student teaching. Sam wants to try again next Sunday. He didn't feel good about his class. Nice young man. I called Neva. She called Barbara. Barbara told her re our crisis. I wrote Roger, niece/nephew letter, Shirley Olson and Nancy. Wrote to Neva in some detail re "crisis last week" — tore it up. Told Barbara I'd decided to talk to the Dean of Students. She said she understood but looked hurt.

12 Feb 1979, Mon

I talked to Merlin Waite. I have discharged my responsibility ~~with~~ by talking to Pop. Ione Tiu. A pleasant man. I forgot my literature class. Am relieved re my duty — Merlin explained the Bishop's court.

I had my car — tail pipe (?) muffler (?) repaired — a quiet car.

Barbara said she now can talk to people re Dava — the worst seems to be over. She said she has felt better since she talked to her mother.

Grace Morse and I went to the ward family home evening at the Visitor's Center.

Letters from Ruby Davis, Julia Thornley and Arlene Hawkins.

I'm sitting with my heating pad —

13 Feb 1979, Tues

A pleasant evening in the temple. ~~Barbara~~

14 Feb 1979, Wed - Happy Valentine!

Robert came in for a chat. I was calm - outwardly - it took courage for him to come. He asked if he could still call me Aunt Laveria

A harrasing lab. I will probably do only one canning project in the future and one kind of jam at the most.

I went over the Relief Society lesson again.

15 Feb 1979, Thurs

A better lab - a better teacher?

We had a good turn out in Relief Society. A number of Samoan sisters. I felt frustrated because I felt I was not communicating with them. Actually I felt I wasn't communicating with anyone!

Letter from Nava. She is as helpless as I was re- Tova's situation.

I was warmed by the interest of one Samoan sister re the meaning of two words - "stewardship" and "express". Impressed that she would ask.

16 Feb 1979 Friday

It continues to be cloudy and raining much to the disgust of the semester in Hawaii students - and to the tourist to Hawaii I should imagine.

We rec'd a letter from Tova. She verbalizes of the realness of pain.

Bobson and a friend, Dave, made cookies. I went to the opera - "Il Trovatore" - beautiful music. The tenor was not well - cut out the second scene of Act III.

17 Feb 1979 Saturday

I woke without an alarm at 5:30 and went to two sessions in the temple. Comfortable ones. Barbara, Marc & I went to Wendy Christensen's dinner/reception. Tables were decorated beautifully. The program was Hawaiian. Sister Dorothy Hader donated two

hules which made us cry. One to "Beyond The Reef" and another to one of the alpha group.

18 February, Sunday.

Another rainy day. I wrote lots of letters.

19 February Mon - Happy Holiday.

I wrote a few more letters. Washed.

20 February Tuesday

I feel somewhat caught up at school. Clinton Kanehale's funeral. A pleasant evening in The Temple. I have a cold.

21 February Wed.

My Wednesday lab is the first time 'round. I'm glad to see the the errors of my lab sheet. My leg hurts.

22 February Thurs

A night's rest didn't take care of my leg. A better lab - a better teacher? - We got out a little early. I got papaya. Left the car and walked home. Pain. Got almost to the temple parking lot, campus side and my left leg gave out. After about forty-five minutes and slowly hobbling, I made it to the entrance of the Visitor Center. A painful, painful, humbling, frustrating experience. Frightening. I came home and went to bed. I was awake when Barbara got home. She was concerned.

23 Feb, Friday

Caught my 8:30 class seated. Crutches - too heavy - from Sister McKim. Angelina Hsu brought me some from the Health Center. I called Dr. Botticelli's office. Drove in. It took me twenty-five minutes to find a parking place. By the time I got in I was practically in tears. He, for, his nurse, made an appointment with Dr. Chun-Hoon, an orthopedist. - three hours

later! I tried to eat lunch - hobbled back to my car & dozed. Harvey Halverson had given me the keys to Vivian's apartment but it seemed hardly worth the effort to go. At 3:15 I hobbled up to Dr. Chun Hoan - eyes - he doesn't know the problem - ruled out several things - arthritis, pulled legs - ment. I have an appointment to have a bone scan Tuesday. Once again it seemed too complicated to go to Vivian's. Went to Kam Shopping Center - had dinner - to Nuana Ward - parked by door - rested in Relief Society Rm until 8:10 when my first session of "Family Budgeting" started. There were 1000. They seemed fairly receptive. The adrenaline came to the rescue and I made it through. I didn't dare take the pills the Dr. prescribed because they were ad against drowsiness and not taking while driving I was glad to get home and in bed. I'd just turned off the light when Barbara returned home from having Lucille Johnson speak at the Know Your Religion lecture series. She enjoyed her

Family Home Evening. Lesson given by Joan Bennett - re kinds of prayer - excellent examples from scriptures and a film strip, comparing prayer to a telephone -

Tues, 8 May 1979

Rainy. We need it. Worked on Leadership Mtg. In to do the Soc. Relations Dept this Friday night. Lessons on "Accepting Calls & Releases Discerningly" and "Heretics" - I wasn't very gracious in accepting this assignment. In afraid. And that's the name of one of the lessons: "Accepting Calls and Releases Discerningly".

Wednesday, 9 May 1979

To Honolulu library, checked out 7 - some heavy - books & found two pictures re architecture in homes. My leg & back protested, and even more as I went to Liberty House & Woolworth looking for bedspreads & T-shirts.

Picked up a lei for Grace Morse for Mother's Day on my way home. Was glad to get my recliner's letter from Neva & a note from Winifred Morse McFadden.

Tue. 13 May 1979 - Happy Mother's Day

Rose Christensen & wife woke me at 7:20 AM with a fresh, fragrant lei. Mother's Day. Visited with Murel Moody & delivered her leis from Sister Alofi. We discussed the zillions of little baskets - mites - on their garden. I'd put four last night but had to leave them outside. She's a pleasant person.

all five students today. Marie Maxwell did quite well with her mixed teaching. Harvey Moai stayed after class to make up his class last week. Wrote Nancy, Rhett, Neva, Barbara. Called Gladys Banks. Had a nice visit.

Mon. 14 May 1979

Housing committee meeting. FHE. Vickie A. gave the lesson. Just three of us present.

Tues. 15 May 1979

To Honolulu to U of H library. Found three House Beautiful issues on Shibui.

Wed. 16 May 1979

Have a new floor in the kitchen & bathroom.

Thurs. 17 May 1979

at 3:30 AM Mark & Adele Gardner, their three children and Rex Abernethy arrived from Samoa. She had written but I hadn't rec'd her letter.

So the temple, my back is rebellious. So Devotional. Hellets, at least Barbara, is cooling re their trip to Peru. David McDougall spoke - nice talk. So Julia Cawley for a rest. So Relief Society. Rex & Mark came over. They don't have reservations. Error made in Apia. Stalled after Relief Society to find he had gone to Pres. Andersen! I'm afraid I expressed my amazement. So Julia's (Vivian's) for the night.

Friday, 18 May 1979

called Gardner after class. They'd been to Laine Travel. Still didn't have PCC tickets - met them at 11:00 AM - got them some - price has gone up to \$23.75 for pkg. Went back to school & worked with the slides Jay Wrathall took last semester. Made an appointment for him to take some more.

Home. Lunch. Rex & Adele & the two young ones came just as I was leaving. They have reservations! Stopped by Vickie (at Laine Travel) to exclaim & thank her. She said they came in with Lavine Harper & Pres. Andersen "sent us". She was surprised too.

So Julia's - relaxed on the floor & dozed on the couch - So Chinese restaurant for dinner.

Sat. 19 May 1979

21 May 1979, Monday

Thurs, 24 May 1979

Sat. 2 June 1979

Washed. A birthday card for my sister Wilma. A letter from Rhett Willmore. Read & reclined most of the day.

Sun. 3rd June 1979

Opelia Carter called.

Harvey Morse didn't come to class but called this evening. He had taken his wife to the hospital. Kidney stone?

My mouth gets so dry fasting. The alternate zide doesn't help - some of the side effects even with water.

Mon. 4th June 1979

Ron Cuzer was absent today - With a class so small you really miss one person.

Dr. Chen Hon - More sprays. Possible opinion on disc pressing in neck/s though can't see on x-rays. Another spray possible - prefer doing only if surgery necessary. Suggested therapy - hospitalization because nearest access to therapy is at Castle Hospital or Wakeima - the travel afterwards counteracts good done - about a week. In June. On the 24th. This probably means no mainland travel. I should be glad that I have two months to hopefully get things under control.

The niece - nephew letter.

Tues, July 5th →

Took Bill & Clarissa Mayfield to Queen's Hospital - took suit home.

Wed, July 6, 1979

Started the Home Management class. Can't seem to get enthused. Mailed tape - family.

Dr. Chen Horia nurse called. Everything is set for June 24th - to the hospital.

I ache from my neck to my ankles.

Thurs. June 7, 1979

Woke about 3:30 - no comfortable position. The first night I haven't been able to sleep, up - 2 Enacins, heating pad and the rest of the night in the recliner. Pain eased.

20 bookstove - 2 boxes of stationery on sale. 20 Relief Society - the lesson taught by Karen Foster was a good one - reviewing the name of the Savior. It rained - heavily - on my one minimum left on the line. Was sunny as left Relief Society.

I had to shed a few tears at Vivian's tape re. Clark -

Took Clarissa ^{Mayfield} to Queen's Hospital in Honolulu. Bill, her husband, has a lovely view of Honolulu, a corner room. He seemed quite relaxed about the surgery. Two nurses came to talk to him, about what to expect. I like this procedure.

My whole body aches. I must learn to stop before I get so tired. Got another heating pad, recliner and I feel better. Julia Carter called. She's appalled. Was on a D.C. 10

and none are flying.

Friday, 8 June 1979

Karen Maeda did well on her exam.

Zaastaka for lunch. Filled me up for the day.

Bill Mayfield's surgery went well.

Letter from Sallie & Nancy.

All set for the Tanager girls & two girls from Idaho to come for dinner Sunday.

Dipped recipes for next week's jam demonstration.

Saturday, 9 June 1979

Wilma Hirschmann's birthday.

Watered my lawn all day. Buy.

20 Kanoehe. Bought a stereo.

Sunday, 10 June 1979

Crushed that Harvey Moea didn't come to do his micro-teaching. Bro. Makiea brought the students up — a little embarrassing.

Salote I —, Seine Uea, Nedala & Solak Unge and Bettie Cronabala & Shelia (two girls from my Performance class) came for dinner. I was going to put my bath in the soon to be lake while I was a church. — the boy broke off. I had a real struggle getting it open and got to see my car time — I used a hammer, a screw driver, knives. I was just sweating. They didn't stay long after dinner — a foreword.

Mon, 11 June 1979

Read a little in the Management text — picked up stainless steel flatware at Liberty House in Kaula. Took Vivian Halverson's car, giving it a drive. Need to do Julia Curves tomorrow.

Tues, 12 June 1979

Wrote Fern, Anne & Blaise & Blaise Valley.

made a batch of lelebae jam - arrived on the first
analysis. Before added pestin thanks address.

I feel quite good.

Windy. Sprinkled the front lawn - water blew
all over.

Lunched at Kusuma. Service slow. Expensive.

Wed. 13 June 1979

Alan - absent. Lari finished back. Ken Mills
stopped taking notes - curving his mustache.

Chadene Furuta has had her baby - a girl -
Cassian.

To Dorothy Hede's viewing. I'm still not at
ease offering condolences. I don't mind looking
at the corpse so much anymore. Mr. Heder, the
youngest daughter, Cassa - the sons - were all red
eyes. The program sounded nice. I couldn't
stay - to the airport to meet Julia Caver.

Picked six or seven cherry tomatoes on my
plant.

Julia's plane had come in but she was
nowhere in Dept - I paced for 20-30 min then
decided to sit. She found me. My legs-back
were rebelling. I repented of yesterday's thought
of calling Dr. Chen Hoon and questioning my hos-
pitalization. Jay Fox was on the same plane.
Nice visit enroute to Laie. It's good to have Julia
back. Joe messed her.

Julia C & I had dinner at the Chinese restaurant in Honolulu. Good.

Wrote Yvonne Bliss.

The weather is pleasant in the evenings as the sun goes down.

Sat. 16 June 1979

Clara Mayfield picked me up at eight & I rode with her to Honolulu to the hospital to pick up her husband at Queen's. We had a four and a half hour wait. I wrote Delma; Helen M. & Nava. It about took care of the day.

A tape from Gladys Banks. After playing one side it kept flipping off. Did finally hear it all.

Julia C stopped by. Went to call Nava and did try, knowing she might be in bed - would've been 10:30 pm this time but a sweet voice came on the line to say they were having problems with their equipment and to replace the call.

Sunday, 17 June 1979

It was nice being able to attend the Gospel doctrine class. The students in our Teacher Development class observed today. In our class afterwards I told them I was going to the hospital on the 24th. They were excited - Heilala particularly, about having a party.

Thelma & Sam Chang were our Sac. mtg speakers. Thelma mentioned how her mission had made her a "real gabber". She spoke with such feeling about accepting calls from the Bishop and shed tears of sorrow concerning those who refuse calls.

My home teachers came. Shawn ^{Patulike} asked if they could. He and his brother, Chal, looked so nice today. White shirts and brown suits.

Called to Nevada (Smith). Don. Barbara moved to an apt.

Mon. 18 June 1979

The students really "took hold" of the budget assignment. Kerri Mello & Sheila Richards had some disagreements! She said she was certainly going to discuss finances with her boyfriend before they get married.

Started - long overdue - my management class. I've read two chapters and started on the assignments.

A letter from Barbara Smith. I hope she can get a cop - Sch - beauty - something to work for. Met Vivian Helgeson at the airport. She'd been up 24 hrs - caught in the DC 10 grounding.

Grace Morse, Tammy + Cynthia Jones came over for a little visit. They had reported a bunch of bananas "stolen from the garage" Tuesday. I found who the thief was - Yochi (Zyn's old) Sarda!

Tues. 19 June 1979

On the 9:00 AM temple session.

Clarissa Mayfield came. Wants me to be partying for her family sealings when they're ready.

Said ~~that~~ about my hospital plans.

Washed my temple dress. No need to get the sleeves in my long one.

Wed, 20 June 1979

Final given. Grades in.

Thurs. 21 June 1979

Write Barbara Smith.

I need four ~~new~~ tires. Discovered my spare has not been useable since I left last spring!

Relief Society lesson. So-so - In temple session in AM -

Another happy, glowing letter from Edith H. Bennett.

Fri, 22 June 1979

Took my car to Mr. Herd for tires. Had windows. Made cookies. Made lasagna for dinner tonight. Picked up car thanks to Barbara Belle's transport.

Vivian Pope called. Bless her heart. Was concerned about me. I sent her Nevada's last letter. She assumed I was having surgery. Hadn't received the family tape. Called to Clive.

Grace Morse, her friend Tommy and Cynthia Jones, Grace's granddaughter came for dinner. Lasagna was too done - still tasted quite good. Table looked quite pretty - bougainvillea and plumerias.

Sheena Barber took my cookies to the Family Preparedness fair.

I read Willa Cather's My Antonio. A timeless sublime. # Evenings are so pleasant. Cool after heat of the day.

Sat, 23 June 1979

Graduation. It was a warm (heart) occasion. Devo valedictorian talks. One mentioned Scott Kim as a man who works with his hands and ~~for~~ ^{was a big hand} ~~for~~ ^{for} people. Jonathan Barrett (he was in the English Lit class I audited winter semester) expressed his feeling of love for the students and school and told a personal story about his altercation with Sister Lois Swapp spring term re Health 130. About a week before the

term was over - Valdeitovian speakers already announced - that he was failing health 120. Never had such before. He was taking the class as an independent study and had not lived up to his commitment. She insisted he do the work on a level at which he was capable. All night and he did. Afterwards wrote her a letter thanking her for her integrity, the principle of excellence she had taught. She read his paper - and the letter - told him how difficult it was for her to insist, tears in her eyes - went around the desk and hugged him. He paid tribute to her. I shed a few tears. I had hoped Lois was there to hear it. She and Wylie had been excused from marching in the parade because they had to leave for their Greek trip. I saw Olivia afterwards (her dau.). Read a book about Australia. Rough characters.

Sun, June 24, 1979

Alice Cogdell Best called a little before six. I was already wide awake. She didn't seem to be in any hurry to hang up. It was nice of her to call.

The four Teacher Development Students were in prayer meeting again. Bless them. I expect Paul might have had some problems with active children.

Julia Carter picked me up about ten after one. She missed Sun. Mtg. By Barbara Heltz with a ~~set~~ bag. A pleasant drive in. I heard the first part of Jonathan's ^{2nd} story. He first handed in an assignment, sloppy, poorly written. Lois failed him ~~out~~ after talking to Ric Shumway, head of Communications Division. I'm glad to've heard the first part. Though I had enjoyed the story I had felt one night's work was not sufficient. Good for Lois. Julia Carter had suggested talking to Ric because the Division is so critical of the rest of the faculty regarding our demands of high quality ^{ist} writing.

Wrote in the Admitting area almost an hour. On the third floor where patients all seem to be in traction or have broken bones. My neighbor seems to have been in a bad accident, is on oxygen. Difficult to concentrate on Jesus the Christ with several guests and TV on.

A house? Dr. examined me. Thinks he wonders why I'm here. I feel a bit of an impostor myself. Room is cold. Dinner was good. I was hungry by 5:30 when it was served - the "house diet". The nurse just brought in a bag, bath mat looking heating pad. I'm sleepy. I'll try to write to Rhell at least.

Took a muscle relaxant pill. A tube of blood. If I weren't feeling quite good I'd of my roommate would bag me.

Mon. 25 June 1979

awoke my usual sixish. Slept quite well. On the

PLACE Queens Hospital

DATE 25 June 1979

heating pad. Another "muscle relaxant" (Valium) - I'm not sure I like that.

The Dr. came (Chun Hoon) - explained re-therapy, also will have an electromyogram - for muscle/nerve reflexes. Wrote Rhetl, Esome Arpit.

I therapy - Traction (40#) as I sit on moist heat. The therapist gave me three exercises - Williams - I can only do two very successfully. They are to flatten the stomach (abdomen) and keep the lower back from arching - bowing? -

I continue to feel as if I'm not secure enough to be here - but lets hope it will help -

Left a message for Robert ~~Smith~~ to call me. I'd be sorry not to speak to him before he leaves.

I had the electromyogram - hurt - fortunately didn't last long. Renon Wood called just as he started. Nice of her. Hope she isn't discouraged in calling back.

My left collarbone is sore. Exercise. Have trouble with the core.

I've enjoyed my meals thus far. Fraid I'll gain weight if I continue eating as I have today. Have changed to skim milk.

26 June 1979 - Tuesday

Difficult not to stay sedgy as the Thanksgiving holiday approaches. Did do a little of next week's work. 18 dictionaries came in out of 25. Since it is optional many participated.

Thurs. 22nd. Happy Thanksgiving.

The Turkey got done early. Ended up with only ten! Buddy Gullett didn't ~~come~~ ^{come} ~~help~~ ^{help} Bill Masfield had an emergency. Velez's didn't come. Barbara Gullett made delicious pumpkin pie. It was a lovely dinner. Nice dinner.

26 Nov. Mon

A coolish, cloudy AM.

Classes slow - a number absent - continuing a long weekend. With Standards Committee and a Division mtg.

Mailed \$9.00 worth of Christmas gifts. Bought two large print Bibles - for Wilma & Emilee Hirschman & Lettie & Don Willmore.

FAE re the "Special" (Handicapped) child. Julia Cameron gave the lesson. She likes this area. Did a nice job.

27 Nov, Tues
