7 Jan Mon

Winter semester started. It is good to have full classes — some too full.

8 Jan Tues

A storm. Lights off at 1:00 pm — dark evening. Temple closed.

19 Jan Sat

Julia C. & I went to Kawa from Peligian. Joseph
Spurriver spoke on the church in Hawaii 1850-1875.

Thought I squirmed & squirmed (my knee was aching) & thoroughly enjoyed it. He has amassed a large amount of knowledge from missionary journals. From the time the new Cong. missionaries - Capt Cook came until 1950 Hawaiian population had been on the decrease - except among the Moors.

He told of the introduction on the greeting "Aloha" - a dist. Pres from the Honolulu district took out his white handkerchief as he gave his district report at conf. in Laie, waved it & said, "the members in the Honolulu District send you aloha!" Folded up to take back to Honolulu the conference's aloha.

Laie was bought - 100 acres - for \$4,000!

Queen Kapiolani & her husband visited Laie in 18 - and were greeted by a choir of children, a most unusual sight, few children in Hawaii. Queen K. intrigued by Relief Society - patterned an organization after it all over the island - had missionaries organize them. Forerunner of Kapiolani Hospital.

He also spoke of writing in the red room — a racial comment — underneath it was written, "eat your sacrament on Sunday and go to hell." Related it to James' "true religion" — living —

Tues, 18 Mar 1980

at 6:50 Herb Gellert called to tell me Barbara Gellert, her mother and Greta Gellert were killed in an accident returning from Honolulu. I was stunned. I managed my 7:30 class, talked to some students after who had her as a teacher, worked on my Religion class, Sherie Chamberlain came in — she hadn't heard. I taught my 10:30 class & Beverly Udall came to offer her sympathy knowing of Barbara & my friendship. Brought a loaf of banana nut bread. I was moved to tears. Julia Carver called. I talked to Mary Miles. She will teach Barbara's classes. I was moved to tears again.

I did most of the talking in my Religion class. I went fast.

Mary Miles came at 3:00. We talked a bit and she stayed to look around. I went to the faculty

meeting to hear more of Walter Gorn's theory of teaching.
Ranek "cats in dogs".

Stopped by Herb Gellert's — it's hard — I'm mixed quite well except I didn't tell him how much Barbara meant to me ^{completely} without breaking down & crying.

Came home and listened to tapes on tape. I'm thrilled, also read the manual and checked the test quizzes. They did well — most of them.

Mark Clark called, sounded tired. Herb wants me to pray at the funeral — opening — I pray I can without crying. A woman from Honolulu Star Bulletin called for information — human interest — re Barbara. There must be hundreds of humorous incidents. I couldn't think or talk about any.

Beverly Udaska came in the office after my 10:30 class to offer her condolences because she knew Barbara & I had been good friends, brought a loaf of banana nut bread. I was moved to tears.

Anniversary Day

Wed, 19 Mar 1980

I introduced Mary to her classes — only say in each when they started. The advanced class decided to do the exhibit "in memory of our teacher Barbara Gellert".

Julia Caver, Bina Morse & I went to the program honoring seven "great" L.D. musician-artists. I'd forgotten the reception before — had some rather sumptuous refreshments. Unfortunately I'd eaten. Jay Fox came over and put his arm around me to see how I was doing.

Wilma Hein and Maggie her friend were at the program. It was marvelous. A famous artist in her/his own right introduced the artist — the artist if there performed after the presentation — Bill Lincoln, etc. etc. usually a number or two was performed in their honor. There was rather spontaneous. The awards, framed, were surrounded by leis. The program ended with each artist and the presenter coming up, the Hawaiian Club giving leis & and

godparents. It was a memorable evening. Herb Gellert and Barbara's brother, Bud Peterson, were here.

20 Mar 1980 (Thurs) The day of Barbara Gellert's funeral.

I taped a class for my Interior Design class. Sent Vera & I went over to the Stabe center about nine. Many people came. Madere Pasqual, Bune Kiese, Betty Gray — former students of Barbara's — at least two couples who the Gellerts had befriended — many present students as well. A wonderful tribute to the family. It broke my heart for Pally Gellert to put her arms around me and say, "Mama surely loved you Lavina." I was sorry I looked at Barbara. She didn't look like herself at all. The Hawaiian Club sang Hawaii Aloha — tears — I got through the prayer — short — no one probably heard the "amen" but the Lord — because of the tears which couldn't be contained.

Mark Clark gave a beautiful talk — personal incidences re Barbara, grandma, Janie. Herb gave the eulogy — aided when he got a bit tearful by his brother-in-law, Brad. Brad spoke of the love he'd felt by the people here, the love he'd rec'd from his mother, of Barbara's tolerance and love, of the love they'd shown — bequeathed to their children and thus their ability to love.

He expressed feelings re concern and love shown the those bereaved.

Mark spoke of blame — avoiding it — that it doesn't come from the Lord. Two of the fellow's sisters were at the funeral (the one who was in the other car). I talked to them at the house afterwards in "grandma's room" as we ate after the graveside service.

Attended Tina Foster's baptism and afterwards a dinner. It was nice. She was baptized in the ocean. Looked pretty in a white dress made by her mother.

Went home & fell into bed emotionally & physically exhausted.

21 Mar - Friday

Walter Lauer of Social Security talked to my 8:30 class - a number of absences. At 9:30 - Devotional checked part of the finance exam.

Mark Clark told me that he'd had trouble ~~too~~ getting his funeral talks together - when during the opening prayer the prayer asked that those who participated could do so in a manner satisfying (or whatever was said) he got it together. I appreciated having him share that with me since it was my prayerful. I am grateful for this good man.

To the temple. A busy night. I like following the first session. From there to interlary to second veil - Went immediately to bed on arriving home - Good letters from Neva-Smith - Ellie Jones.

22 Mar. Sat

Up at 5:30 AM for Julia Rancour's baptism. Three others were baptized. Well attended. What a responsibility (challenge) to be baptized without support of family - It rained during the confirmation.
