4<sup>th</sup>, Wed

I went to Enrique DeKeizer's funeral. Not many people. A little different than the Hawaiian funerals. All eight children were here (Susan, Wita, Amour Larsen were the only ones I knew besides her mother.) Meldon Larsen gave a fairly long, self-controlled, well-worded eulogy.

Robert Goodwin spoke. I'm glad I went. He had a heart attack enroute to Honolulu, died shortly after he got to Queen's Med. Center. The DeKeizers stayed in my house one summer. I was surprised that he was 82 yrs. old. They have eight attractive children.

Many security guards. They gave the entertainers a standing ovation. Mr. Ziyang went on the little stage in front of the PCC stage & Ralph Rodgers welcomed him and he responded. Gifts were exchanged.

He stayed longer in here than at any other place on island.

It's cloudy - some thunder - rain. We need it.

Sun, 15<sup>th</sup>

cloudy, rainy AM - Slept in. Wrote Nancy - Gladys + Arlene. Worked on Relief Society Leadership mtg. Ward conf. Stake R.S. Bd. mtg - Watched Masterpiece Theater.

Mon, 16<sup>th</sup>

Three of the girls who planned to go to NEIB meeting backed out - cost me \$15. Wendy Sheigh, Charlene Horomona + her mother Raavynna Shefford went. It was nice - in the Honolulu Club - long. Three interesting young women spoke (with businesses of their own). A designer (\$150 - 200/outfit), a private consultant + the owner of a maternity shop in Ward Plaza(?) + a new business "Chocolate Moose" - children's store. The former "In Bloom".

27 Jan 1984

Did the rest of my income tax

Had a steak pie from yesterday's purchase.

Startled when when Gloria Cronin noted I'd had a bad week — crushed that Julia Cameron would have told her — felt betrayed — yet I didn't ask her not to tell —

A pleasant day. Talked to Dean Wright. (Bp) Talked with several students (FSN115). A pleasant group.

Mailed income tax returns.

President Elliott Cameron called to ask me to be on a committee to hear an appeal of a suspended student.

Got up early. Mopped? kitchen floor. Washed rug. after I got home I washed bathroom rug. mopped (with Johnson's no wax floor cleaner) floor.

Went to Pearl Ridge Shopping Center. Crowded - junk. Sales. Had some good clam chowder & a salad.

My clocks don't work.

Elder Neal A. Maxwell spoke at Devotional. He told of how his seven uncles determined he'd be a basket ball player. At 13 he stopped growing. Didn't even make the team. He was pushed to words - first by an English teacher who gave him a D- and promised to continue until he got the "A" he was capable of - He encouraged the students - promising them that they'll (many) be teaching the gospel in countries that they don't even know the names of - how changes take place - the gospel remains the same. To 8<sup>th</sup> ward conference. Nice. Bro — Bergan, an interesting Gospel Doctrine teacher. Rubini Forester did the Cultural Refinement lesson on "Ordei". Did a nice job.

To a meeting at the temple <sup>(for supervisors)</sup> from 3:00 - 5:45. Then to BYU-HC for a general workers' meeting. Dried.

Mon. 27<sup>th</sup>

I'm eating too much.

Letter from Ollie Jones.

Tues. 28<sup>th</sup>

To the symphony. We left at intermission. It was a most worthwhile evening even so.

All ceilings have been painted. Bathroom & first bedroom finished? Can't tell.

1 March 1984

The finance exam was not as bad as I'd anticipated. I made study sheets for both 115 & 200. Time will tell if it helps the former.

The painting is finished except the kitchen walls. I put up back bedroom & 1st living room draperies. Vacuumed the whole house. I'm sore. Washed two batches, two beds are clean. Bookcases have not been put up or hall drapes. I'm tired.

Fri, Mar 2nd

Painting is pau. And they did my cupboards. As I write this they are still a little sticky. Ben — is a nice, thorough man. Lucky the students who work for him.

Relatively light night in Temple. Marvel Buttad is spending the night with me.

Sat, Mar 3rd

Breakfasted with Marvel. Got my bookcase backs together. My home looks lovely!

To Haleiwa for pizza. Some grocery shopping. Home for a zap: A little more shopping in Hauula.

To the third Na Makua program. Ismael Stagner's 3-3/2 hour biannual production with Julia Caver, Gloria Cronin. Some delightful moments as one family (11 children) of Lahaina, Maui, all senior citizens now, performed and the three numbers by some of the past Laie PCC dancers in tribute to Wifie Swaypp who "brought back" the Hawaiian male dance — and started the PCC format.

4 Mar 1984

24 June - Sun Greenbelt, Md to Los Angeles - Anaheim

Cloudy again - Leisurely breakfast, Wilma took me to the airport after she'd settled Nancy - I don't like to leave - of course I can't stay - wouldn't want to actually.

Uneventful flight via Pittsburg to Los Angeles - Constant plying of drinks - food -

On arrival in LA my bag did not arrive. Bus to Disneyland Hotel. Sat with a woman returning from a week in New Orleans. I.D. - convert, mother of 5. Left her husband after 37 years of marriage - he a high councilman - she, not active, but seems to like the church.

My flight will be to San Francisco, Denver, Chicago & to Charlotte tomorrow at 7:53 - Tava & Wilma are leaving in the AM & will meet me in Charlotte. Edwin has to go back to Ca. Wednesday.

Sun. 25<sup>th</sup>

The night on the plane was pretty rough. Put on my sweater - in lieu of blouse - in San Francisco. Denver airport is crowded - rest room lines long on the concourses. Wrote a few letters - Helen Moffat. Each airport change. I'd think I wouldn't get on - but I did. Wilma & Tava met me in Charlotte.

Still worked on the inventory and the niece-nephew list.
