Called Neva's. She and Lettie "went to Idaho" — left Saturday, were to spend the night in Brigham City with Bryan and Jira Smith.

Watched "O Pioneers" TV show. Don't remember the book that well. (Willa Cather)

3rd, Mon

16th, Sun

Snowed until about 11:00 AM, heavy, wet snow.

Paula came over for Sacrament meeting. A good one. Bro. Cooper of the High Council spoke. He told about his 96 year old friend. Met her, when he was thirty, she 80 and the Bp. asked him to take her to church.

He gave a touching talk of her demands, of learning to love via service, of some understanding to her constant question of "why am I still here?" She has/is teaching him to serve, to love.

I heard Bro. Hugh Hibley again, the third lecture via TV of his 50⁺ Book of Mormon classes. The last two weeks he is telling the condition in Jerusalem at Lehi and Jeremiah's time. Today he talked considerably of Jeremiah. Some of Laban, his position as captain of the guards - in city and out.
