Thank you note from Wilma Hirschmann.

Dimple Mellow called. Suggested Neva and me to lounge with her & Carl to Logan Monday. He has a meeting. Nice of them.

Lunch with Neva, Maria, Jack and Eric Wood.

To Chapman library (put The Beauty of Adam and Eve by Mark Twain on hold - both copies checked out) - to Payless -

Stopped at Bryan & Tina Smith's in Brigham City on our way home.

Had an hour rest at Shirley's. Drove on arriving home at 6:00 pm. Pleasant day.

11th, Tues

Walked. Washed a batch. Entered some messages on Temple ready. No problem in having my hair at the computer extended.

Picked up box at Nordstroms.

Home and visiting teachers.

To Dr. Miller, ophthalmologist. Big group in waiting room. 50 minute wait. Pressure good. Cataracts growing.

Long rest in the pm in anticipation of the opera.

Winnie & Jim MacLaculen picked us up. Dinner at Marie's. A wonderful performance of Verdi's opera ^{MacBeth}

18th, Tues

Worked on Moseleys. Picked up Marie Ward. Her old apartment was in the apt. house that Betty & Keith gethers lives in. Two hours all told, all night. A beautiful sky blue day.

Talked to Walma Hirschmann. Eric (son) had called yesterday to say they were ok. No electricity — otherwise only effect two pictures had fallen down in their apartment. # Talked to Julia Thornley. She's had the flu.

Letter from Shirley Berlin. She and Elliott have moved into a retirement home complex.

We have an appointment to visit Joann Whipple's

Kater: a nice visit.

19th, Wed

Emily Morse called to invite me to see her amaryllis — five blooms, the one I gave her for Christmas. Went late morning. She told me many times how amazing it is that these five flowers could come from such a small bulb. And it is.

Packed (?) away Moseleys & got out S & S class material. Xeroxed a few more sheets.

21st, Fri

Mulled over S & S lesson. Xerox some. Richard White asked if I'd like to do some work for him. Suggested Marquieite Payne.

Picked up 3 prescriptions. Walked halls of Physicians Bldg.

Talked to Marie Ward.

Mailed cleaning recipes to Wilma H - copy of Shirley Berlin's letter and ^{map} house plan.

Papas were in hospital with Ryle for most of the pm. Will spend the night with Son Arden.

22nd, Sat

Worked over S & S lesson a little more.

Letters from Grace Lee and Paula Hirschmann.

To Distribution Center, Desert Book, Mormon Handicraft. So nice to stay in all day.

Papas came. Clive & Ryle saw Legacy again. Visited with Clive a bit on their return. Vivian & I have came down - ate some of Wilma's dried fruit. Made a little supper then Vivian stayed until about 8:00. Gladys called. Commented that she thought I'd been avoiding her - answer. ^{Paul} Later had a nice visit with her.

23rd Jan 1994

22nd Jan

Week's lesson went well. So did mine - Before the prayer I asked the class (thel?) trivia question: When is the first incident of passing the buck? Nile Wright answered: Eve, when she blasphemed Satan. Class murmured en masse - 'Course he did it as a ruse.

Saved my diuretics to take when I get home, it happens it is all right. I know it's best to take the same medication the same time each day.

Woke / got up with a pain ⁱⁿ on the outside of right I guess insulin got me through - on fast didn't make it during class. When I got up after sacrament morning seemed hardly walk.

Vivian assisted me home. Took two Ecobins w/ diuretics - lay down - later went to heaven for lunch, after eating lunch to the couch, leg propped up - Woke about 4:30 - leg seems some better.

There is a lesson outlined for the 5th Sunday: Listen to a Prophetic Voice.

Read 3 chapters of next S.S. lesson.

Watched the church's Friends focusing on children. Elder Russell Ballard spoke as did Presidents Hinckley, Benson and Primary Ken. President Brassfield (P).

24th Mon
A Donna Pope & friend, Vanda, stopped in.

Leg much easier. Just feels sick behind my knee.

Washed, looking. Neva helped me turn mattress.

Neva, Vivian & I went to the bugles for lunch.

Reading Clyde Edgerton's Walking Through Egypt. Vivian library book.

No A Funny Thing Happened on the Way ... So I'm - not my 'cup of tea'. Vivian used somebody's ticket.

25th, Tues

When I went up to heaven about 9:00, they had already gone to Brigham City.

Called the day away. Read for S.S. lesson.

Note / checks from Ellie Jensen for OT tape / study guide still requested. Note from Wilma H with a box to Julia Thornley.

Date 26 Jan 1994

Wed. 26th

Slept/lay in until 8:00 - cloudy - snow in mountains & preserve.

Read re D & S, R.S. lessons, Scripture. Worked on Moseley. Gladys brought Mexican food for dinner.

She pretty well stayed put today.

Neve returned late pm. She helped Dina finish quilting her quilt.

Gladys enjoyed MacLachlan's Baby. Arlene thought it "weird."
Thurs. 27th

Organized R & S lesson for D & L Home. Talked to Barbara Pederson. Wayne, her husband, has prostate cancer.

Wrote Nellie Jones / sent her a refund. (She over-paid me for the OT material I sent her.)

Lunched with Winnie MacLachlan and Neve.

Gladys Banks stopped by with the book about a Hopi woman she told me about yesterday. Hadn't dropped off the MacLachlan book at the library so I could give her the due date slip that Vivian had taken out.

The last of my income statements came (other than H & H words & YK). Organized income & contributions checked to make sure I'd paid ample tithing - \$100+ over - Okay -

Reading in Covington's compilation of the Church Presidents - as well as Church News articles of Presidents Benson, Kimball & Lee. The articles particularly Pres. Kimball's much like the Covington one (Naturally! Both written by his son.).

Fri. 28th

Mailed Wilma's "fang in there dog".

Lovely, sunny, cold day.

Dimple & Carl Mellor visited an hour or so.

I'm reading Helen Sebagueptewa's biography - not too well written. Even so interesting. A Hopi woman. She was 71 when it was first published. (Written by Louise Udell who died in 1974)

Jan 29 Jan 1994

Sat. 29th

up at 5:30 AM - took medication, back to bed
up at 7:00 AM -

Neva & I met Gladys at the DT Symposium. I lasted through four sessions. We each took a few snacks for lunch. I heard three talks by Robert Melhous and another - UofU Institute teacher re the land of Palestine.

Came home via Ky. Fried Chicken. Bought two pieces. Slept soundly afterwards. I think I'll go over to the Symphony. Neva got home about 4:30 pm.

Did go over to the first half on the symphony. My legs protested a bit. Concert lovely. She played rather busily for a Chinese. Interesting upper two movements as she headed to the music.

Cold, breezy sunny day. Went to our ward R.S. and then taught the lesson. Came Listen to a Prophet's Voice in the S & F Home. The attendance seems rather small. Fred Winder looks so fragile. So does Ardella Baugh. She showed a blessing Pres. Spencer W. Kimball gave her "... that her sons would rise up to call her blessed". I sure this has already been fulfilled. She has terminal cancer. Back to the ward to take my pictures. Fat looked Janys & _____ who spoke at Sacramento meeting last week. Was able to compliment them on their excellent talks. # wrote Bob Melville

Made Chicken Omelette - cooked a pot of rice. Ate and slept soundly. (Did get up at 5:00 to take my medication - does make church meetings easier.)

Mon 31st

Took medication early (5:30 AM)

Washed several small batches. Made Bran Muffin recipe. To the 10:15 AM temple session. Quite large. Bro. Cox (S & F Home Branch) took #1 part. Did it with quiet dignity. I sat by Shirley Hudge in the session.

After a rest went to Western Nut, to Fred Meyers, Chapman Library, Albertsons & Payless.

Visited with Neva.

to wash. Washed apricot table cloth in hopes I won't have

Kings Cottage Art Gallery for framing.

For the first time I put my parking card & comb on my purse before I had my car washed. Forget — and thought it had been taken or vacuumed up. Returned to car wash. Paul Paul — one of the managers — looked and looked. all set to ask Dale Porter for another when about four blocks from home I remembered —
Awww —

Bought a new lock for storage unit. Lost, knocked it off as I got potatoes and powdered milk, never mind the lock & needed a sturdier one.

Note from Tina Smith, Mahala for steering wheel cover. A thoughtful young woman.

5th, Sat

Lazy, lazy. Finished the Martha Graham book.

Bought a few groceries, ate lunch at Casa. Made a pot of sweet sour vegetable soup, interesting to the symphony. Left before the last number. Gladys is shopping for a car.

Keith Jenkins called. He has been in town for two days. Keith Giles called. My income tax is ready.

6th, Sun

Byron Reed died. He will be missed. He did the Sacrament table ever since I've been in the ward. Large attendance in SS class.

Shelma Kioatobe gave the best lesson I've heard her give.

7th, Mon

To Family Hist Library after outlining six chapters of SS lesson.

Picked up income tax. After three tries got Palestine maps. Lunch at the Pantry of Lion House.

Visited Marie Ward & Jeanne Whipple.

David Smith surgery went well.

Letter from Ullie Janda.

Watched Fried Green Tomatoes.

Wilma Hirschmann called last night. Had rec'd the Henry in the day!

Date 1 Feb 1994

Tues, 1st

Wilma & Paula have reservations for an Alaska cruise in July. They'll stop in S & L on their way home.

Went to Family History Library. Checked most families off on the Ancestral File.

Have out at 10:45 AM. To DMBA, Desert Credit Union, and took income tax to Keith Gilce.

Bladys stopped by with Byll new issue - had lunch. Was beat when she left at 2:00 pm - Slept.

Body pillow came. I will be interested to try it out. I sent the pillow case back. Didn't fit.

Letter from Mary Miles.

News & Arlene felt tremors from a 4.5 Idaho-Wyoming border earthquake.

Called several places re body pillow cases. Zick.

Fri, 4th

Date 8 Feb 1994

Tues, 8th

Wed 9th

Called Wilma Hirschmann. Feels AWFUL. This is only her 4th chemo treatment. So to have 7. Cures. Also talked to Lottie Willmore. And Marie Ward. To Family History Library. Perusing Lenoir Co. NC Heritage book. Met Julia Carver at the Inn for lunch. 2 delicious special for price of one. Good salmon. Brought my Swan (left over) to Neva.

Restless rest. Kept thinking of Gladys who was upset about her car purchase.

Thurs, 10th

Up early. Washed three batches. Worked on S & S lesson. Shirley & Preston Olsen stopped by. Had lunch with Neva & Winnie McLachlan.

Dorothy Schwanefeldt has/is buying a condo. Visited with Olsens - start changed my nap.

Gay Mitchell came at 3:00 pm. Told me of Jacob's Temple Experience (Jacob's Ladder). She told me a little joke. As someone was squishing water in carpet in ward library - said they were practicing quising quipes. Bp. Jan-

have told a joke: Do you know what the mashed grape said? Nothing just wined.

Madysa picked me up; drove out to get her car; drove her old one to her sister Ruth Alieglauer.

Neva shared letters from Shirley & Blair Olson to son Dale, also her Valentine designed/made by Gina Smith, a rare event: to mail - even junk.

11th, Fri

Snow, Windy - slick.

To Family History Library until about 1:00 pm.

Were going to know your Religion tonight. Excellent talk on the importance of the temple by Michael Wilcox.

He referred to Gen 28 regarding temple experience.

12th, Sat

Took medication early. Julia Thornley called. Sterling is having surgery Monday. Madysa Barbo called - also.

Neva and I left for Springville about 8:30 AM - put the sheepskin on their (David & Tammy Smith) recliner. It was looking pretty worn -

Took Caitlin and Amanda to Wanda's / ~~Eric's~~ ^{Eric's} baptism. Becky, Denny and children arrived the same time we did. All in Sunday clothes. Looked nice.

A nice baptism - Eric, and another boy. Don baptized and confirmed Eric. Gave him a beautiful blessing after the confirmation.

A good / appetizing buffet at Woods after the baptisms. Johnson's dropped me at the mall. I had about five minutes before the bus came. I was glad to lie prone shortly after my 3:00 pm arrival.

Used Neva's dust devil on my furniture and kitchen and carpet edges, floor boards. Some dusting.

13th, Sun

I was up early / took medication.

Marquette Payne taught Relief Society. The pedigree chart went over quite well as did the discussion of the 5 traditions / customs. The class was quite responsive. Much undiscussed.

Date 27 Feb 1994

Sun, 27th

Came out of church to wet, big flaky snow.
I think I have another lump on my left breast.

Don & Pagan Willmore are coming Thursday evening
3rd March.

Mon, 28th

Walked.

To Family Hist Lib after making an appointment with
Dr. Rosenthal. He made salmon patties for lunch - apt. smells it.

Dr. R. took tissue from lump (thinks it's a build
up(?) of scar tissue. She made me feel I'd "done" the
right thing to go in -

Picked up fruit at Smiths. Dropped UT tapes off
at Gladys'. Short visit with Arlene - told her I'd
been to the Dr.

Judy Craig called. Her mother died a week ago.

Tues, 1st Mar

Called Marie Ward. So beautiful for Arthur
Haycock's funeral. Gorgeous flowers - many Hawaiian
contributors. Presidents Manson and Hinkley were
the speakers. The current First Presidency Secretary
gave the eulogy. Ralph Rodgers sang "Oh Divine Redeemer".
Merry Brown sang a hymn. Spoke to Donna Brown.

They came just for the funeral. Large congregation.
Many General Authorities were in attendance. I sat by
the Godfrey's daughter and David (?) Hanneman's son.

Got home about 1:40 pm. He dropped off the Chinese wren,
