Talked to Julia Thornley (Sterling has a cold), Helen Moffat, Julia Carter, Edith Hunsell.

Did a little printing for S.S. class.

To the Symphony.

Sun, 5th

attended Teacher Development class - under protest I'll admit - wow - will I ever be like Mary? - during S.S. class.

Called Shirley Olsen. Neva & I will go to Logan Tuesday. The weather is supposed to continue mild.

Julia Thornley feels Sterling is a little better.

Wrote Shirley Olsen. Wilma Fullmer and Barbara Storey.

Mon, 6th

Worked on S.S. lesson. To Utah - Idaho School Supply for a chalk holder. To AMBA to have tax deduction changed. To See's Candy to buy some candy for Dorothy Schwanewelt.

Ate lunch in the Garden Room of the J.S. Memorial Bldg. Soup "slopped" - didn't care for salad as well as when I ate with Mary & David Miles.

Reading a Henry Doherty book.

Bought another ratatouille - had part of it for supper. Letter from Delma Coster. Lots of flu in her family.


Tues, 7th

Neva & I went to Logan. First visited Ralph & Delma Olson. From there to Dorothy Schwanewelt; Shirley Olsen was there. Dorothy has a lovely card.

Picked up Ruby Howe at LDS Employment Office where she and husband, Gordon, are part time or vic. missionaries.

Shirley drove us up/around USU campus - up to some of the new homes east Logan.

8 Feb 1995
