Lettie came down - from Neva - to quilt about
7:30 AM - I got up shortly afterwards.

She, Neva and I quilted until about 12:30 pm. Wilma
and Keith Fuller came. Have a report of Barbara Stora's
wedding.

Lettie, Don & I went to Crownburgers for lunch.
Lettie and I had a quarterpounder, Don a Jr. Crownburger
and we shared onion rings. Don got Neva a quarter
pounder, dropped it off on their way home. I went to
Dr.'s appointment. Since I was a little early, went to the
Phy. Therapy department to get a yellow thermal band.

Stacey with whom I worked is in Montana where
her husband is going to school. Has a baby.

Dr. Rosenthal aspirated the hard spot she was con-
cerned about on my left breast. I'm to call her Monday
for lab results.

Slept cozily well after sex when I first woke up.

Neva came down. She took the quilt - off the frame.
Her husband will come later today for the frames and
hoop. # Summarized (?) events of 1996. Put 1996 journal to rest.
Tallest plants in bulb garden over a fast
Christmas card and picture (family) from the
Eric Hirschmanns.
Sunny cold days.

Sun. 5th

In bed ten hours. Awake.

Ward pastor Jim Barner gave the prayer in the

Washed bedding. So aquatic. The pool was open
Friday. Desk didn't know.

Made chicken salad. Not enough mayonnaise -
chicken-macaroni soup.

A too long rest. T/RED

Edith Gunnell called. She'd had an interesting
weekend at husband Frank's grand daughter's wedding
diving in L.A. area.

Ordered some party hose.

Raffold and crocus partially open in bulb
garden.

DATE 7 Jan 1997

To Dr. Lakay's appointment. ¹⁷⁴/₉₄ - ~~curse~~. Lipped Vas-
tec. Wonder how much medication I can tolerate.

To library to drop off books, breakfast at Village Inn
- slow service. Mailed Ehad Gamagan Kintlaw

Cool cloudy, raw day out.

Wrote Belma Coston. Just ^{as} I finished she
called! Wanted me to get a copy of their wedding
license. They can't find theirs. Jim will be 62
tomorrow. Simple and Carl were there five or
six days last week. Hirschmanns did go after Christ-

mas.
Wed. 8th

up 6:00-ish. Washed a load. To aquatics.
Stopped by Gladys and Arlene for tickets to
Grand Theater to be exchanged.

Wendell Smith spent last night with Neva.
He came down - will get me a new switch. Was
being picked up about the time I left.

Got the marriage license peacefully. To Reema
and then Grand Theater. Didn't bring my tickets. Anne

hair cut - back to Grand Theater. Can't ex-
change Sweet Charity tickets until the 28th. Have to
pick up Arsenic & all Lavo. Tickets on will call on
the 29th when we attend.

Mailed marriage license. Sent Rick Willmore the
black bean soup.

Neva has an appointment with her new Dr.
Friday. She shared stew fry with me.

Picked up the daffodils. Crocus even under. See
pink/red from another - tulip?

Thurs. 9th

Not only one but three tulips!

To FH Library. I'm going to try putting a few
names on Temple Ready then pick up Iveys for a
while. There is a book I want to see - might be on
the shelf.

Neva was asleep when I went up at 10:00 -
learned later she felt worse today than since

swigery?

Dimple and Carl Mellor came, brought squash, peanuts and butter beans, also a present - beautiful house-slippers - from Selma Coster. They were in NC five days.

Took Utah Motor Licenses form to Dr. Seheya office. When I called Shelia in his office she thought I was calling for the lab report from Sunday blood chemistry test. Just wanted to tell her that I was late getting the form to them.

The Dry cleaners was closed again when I got there - at 4:00 pm again - Went to Smiths and got some expensive but sweet grapes. Will take them to Julia Thornley tomorrow.

Finally wrote to Rife Pope. He's in Rome, N.Y.

Donna Pope stopped for her shirt about 9:15 pm. Interesting young woman - good company.

10 Apr 1997 Fri

3 small loads of wash.

Potatoes and scrambled eggs, orange, milk, toast for breakfast.

Went with Neva to her new Dr. (Parkin) long wait - from 10:50 am appointment, got out at 12:40 pm - Seema nice - thorough - patient, Sympathetic.

Picked up information from her '94 endoscopy + lower HI tests. Lunch a sizzler. We were both tired when we got home. I had a nap.

Credit union and bank statements - including 1996 interest.

11th, Sat

Woke up to snow. Snowed off and on for much of the day. Snow wet.

To Okladog & Alanias, took them some banana squash Carl and Dimple brought. From there to pick up shirt from cleaners (3rd & 4th). On to Julia & Sterling Thornley. Took Julia some grapes - couple other things. Sterling was found asleep in his chair when I got there. Julia looked so tired. Don't think she had her hearing aid in.

Stopped at Red Flame for lunch. Food very reasonable - particularly for seniors. By the time I had secured myself from the salad bar. Servings very generous (entrees)

Forgot met Gene Berry and other Humanities Committee members for skit rehearsal.

Came home from Woods Cross with damp feet.

Read Fred Barb's life story. More detail about war experiences than he probably talked about.

12th Sun

2^o AM - not a great deal of snow.

Trouble getting tape recorder batteries in correctly.

Read Neva's E-Mail from Wilma Fullmer / Mary. Women wards called off meetings including Steven & Maria Smith's ward. Len McKay and two other elders were supposed to speak at sacrament meeting.

S-o-o took after eating.

Listened to last Sunday's Tabernacle choir broadcast featuring Jenny Oka and a harpist. Lou Ann Easter sang a solo part. I wonder if she and husband Jesse are in Utah now. The violin harp and organ number beautiful.

Jules Carter called. Said Bill's (brother) and Nabhis (friend) wards canceled their meetings.

A nagging slight nausea.

The daffodils are beginning to go - Tulips are wide open - A sixth, seventh and 8th crocus are blooming. Crocuses or croc both correct for plural.

13th Mon

Cold - highs low 20's. Only three in therapy class. By main library on my way home.

Have had an E-mail from Eric Hirschman - mostly about his Bardic research.

Visiting - home teachers.

Ordered house slipper and subscription to Big Backyard for Jimmy & Steven Smith's girls.

Sore after therapy.

Tues, 14th

"Rattled" Jveys - almost all in notebook.
visited Dixie Savage. One woman office of 8th
chapter of Juvenile Onset Diabetics.

Christmas card from Thelma Cherry in Lais,
Wak. 15th

Six in therapy class. Gas in car afterwards.
Filled Simoptic and vasotec prescriptions plus couple
of generic ecotrin.

Visited husband and Marie Ward.
Took Marie some potato soup mix - divided it in
two portions. She needed/wanted to talk.

Another - small daffodil practically open.
Sun is out. 32° on balcony.

Made a pot of cream of potato soup plus
carrots, broccoli and cauliflower (frozen - long past
its prime). Soaking some of the navy beans the
Peper sent.

Wed. 16th

In 5:45 AM temple session. It was good to be
there. Out at 7:30!

Wind shield iced over when I got out. Came
back after putting temple clothes away and poured
hot water on windshield with wipers going, rise and

antibiotics every four hours.

High Council topic assignment was on honesty.

20th, Mon

To FHE. Checked library catalog for any
new Sasser entries. Three. One not on shelf.
News is getting a permanent.

DATE 20 Jan 1997 King

did a load of wash. had party house
checked with six or so people to try to get
my second spare ticket disposed of -

Dr. Rosenthal's office closed.

Friday, the 24th.

21st, Tues

called Dr. Rosenthal's office. Went in for her to
check inflamed breast area. 'Continue antibiotics'.

handicapped parking is a boon.

So FHL for an hour or so. Stopped by Wash

27th, Mon
To Aquatics class. Home and "applied heat"
To Dr. Rosenthal. An hour wait. Think she
would have aspirated if she'd wasn't so behind
schedule. Ho back Wednesday.
Bought a new Aquatics class ticket/card
Made soup, set table, picked up another aug-
master prescription.
Gradually getting income statements, one for
48 bonds today
Read another chapter in the Gordon B. Nuneblay
book.

28th, Tues
Sent Rachel Willmore a card.
Read Neva's E mail. The Dr. told her to
see him in six months. Sounds like good
news to me.

Rainy. To FHL. Checked card catalog for
Callera (Miami) and Ballance - four! - and
Sparrows - Few new books in any books -
Not enough Sparrows - in NC - to write down.
So 3CM & Mall. Tried on a couple of

ankle boots/shoes. Had Cajun barbecued chicken and some very good rice at the Food Court. Came home with half of it.

Applied heat to infection and read two chapters of Hinckley book.

Following a call to Bob Schimmy Peter came to fix tap over the bathtub and put a new spring(?) on my door. Peter is a very nice conscientious man.

29th, Wed

To Therapy. To Dr. R. Aspirated.

"Supper" with Arlene - To Grand Theater - to see Arsenic and Old Lace. Got KFC pie when got home.
30th, Thurs.

announcement of David Johnson's Eagle Scout Court of Honor. Nice letter from Becky -

Edith Kunnell picked me up at 11:30 AM. Lunch at Garden Restaurant - To Distribution Center. ~~Got~~ two piece garment. Dr. Taylor from our War waited on me. Caution on new drizilgae fabric - low temperatures drying and washing. No spore neck lines in the future.

I listened to the picnic in the foyer of J & S Bldg. while Edith bought lipsticks at Nordstroms. From there to Raymond's where I picked up skirt and blouse. Edith bought a short sleeve white blouse.

All income tax documents except one. I owe some tithing.

Talked to seven of Nevada children alerting them to her birthday luncheon on the 15th of March and asking for a contribution from each for her notebook.

Talked to Vivian Pope (Vivian is 4½ months pregnant) Lisa nee Mellow re Neva's lunch - Mellow Banquet looked up. Carl Mellow invited us to use their "downstairs" - I accepted. With his help decided on a menu.

Rec'd Neva's E-mail. Holly Stacey is being baptized today.

Brown shopped - Neva went - for Marie Ward's Made black bean soup. Shouldn't have put all the bean water in it (?).

Vivian is coming on the 5th (Wed), Symphony.

2nd, Sun

via meetings. R.D. presidency released. A surprise to me. Eleanor Teal, president, Dr. Taylor, Education counselor, Pearl Simmons and secretary re-sustained.

Irene has had a hip problem the past two weeks and has given up her job caring for Delilah Brown. Hard for both of them.

After a Stauffer's Turkey dinner - didn't eat the turkey but did the potatoes and most of the dressing. Potatoes were good. Finished up my cranberry salad - Sat in my recliner, applied heat and dozed until about 6:30 -

Washed a couple of small loads.

Wrote a memo to Neva's children re lunch on 15th March - prizes, dates due, etc.

Finished writing I Remember Mama. Picked up typing from My Secretary and took the memo, I Remember Mama. Title page for Neva's book looks nice. Took Dr. Miller's wife to DMPT.

Bought quarter pound hamburger at Crown Burger, labeled to give to firm, up lunch menu and have a price quote for Neva's day.

Gladys and Neva came for a bowl of soup. Gladys started her JTC Seminar notes.

5th, Wed

Cooked kidney beans, slow in softening. Therapy class. Took typ material to Keith Giles. Saw those cheval mirrors at Granite Furniture - \$300 -
