Barbara and Harold Jahn came. Shirley Olson and Pam Werner on on their way. They removed the oxygen mask - put nose oxygen back on - she talked to Dr. Ayers and she - and family feel she shouldn't have anymore intensive efforts.

I took Janice Cooper the newspaper "Cricket" when I talked to her. Anne. I talked to Don Willmore -
Donne & Cole Pope stopped in. Sounded awful
Listened to "New Year's in Virginia 1998."

Fri. 2nd

Washed garments.

Wrote the "An gods", the Sammy Cheaps, Ellis Jones, Becky Woodward, Pam Werner long time friend, brought Pam and Shirley (Olson) luggage. Stayed and visited a lot. At 20 Credit Union for cash. Made credit for '98 ch. center

Barbara Storey came. Also Becky and Danny Johnson nice visits with them. Danny went up to News to watch a ball game. Becky heard Steven Smith suggest the possibility of moving to Quora. Her perception quite different from News. She (News) was speaking of "disrupting their lives" - "if closer", Steven suggested and she jumped to conclusion they wanted her to move. We need to hear both sides of the story -

When Becky & Danny Johnson left for the hospital and Barbara went up to beds for some sleep I fell on the couch (5:00ish) brushed - couldn't seem to stay put. Winnie McLellan, Martha Whitehead called.

Sat. 3rd

Early News from the hospital was good. A bad coughing burst the illusion - Dr. met with Shirley, Buzen, Pam, Barbara, Becky and Danny. Pulmonary, vascular systems broken down. After talking to the other siblings the bad decision - with her ^(News) encouragement - to withdraw Oxygen, make her as comfortable as possible - Oxygen taken away at 4:30pm Becky & Barbara picked me up

DATE 3 Jan 1998

after 10:00 - with mask on west in - Bp. was there -
He had called earlier (after I'd talked to Dr. Lohman
about re my infectious period - she was sick herself -
confirmed "Snout Cares" as long as you're coughing")
standing outside door. Thought staff was working with her
just her children.

I held her hand, talked to her, she was lucid -
Danny met his boys - Dg. ^{Johnson} drove the truck - with
difficulty through the canyon. He and David Johnson
were able to speak to Neva, makes me want to write
about it.

I came home called our sisters, Winnie Mc Laeklan
and Ruby Haws.

Delma Costan called this morning, David Harper
had told her about Neva being in the hospital.

Winnie + Jim came here from the hospital
where Neva knew her - and Jim - though I doubt if
she could really see him - at least in detail.

The girls sing to Neva -

David Harper called to ask about Neva. I was
wondering if I should call Delma. David said he
call her and Ullis.

Werna Hirschmann is coming on the 5th,
4th Sun.

up before 8:00 AM. Bobby, Bryan, Barbara and
Shirley went up to the hospital about 3:30 AM -

Wanda came up. A new Dr. came this AM -
questioned Neva about her wishes, questioned Bryan +
Barbara - belted them it sounded like - Curses.
Bryan, Bobby, Danny and Wanda are going home. It's
5:00 pm.

The Bp stepped in. Martha Whitehead taped RB
for me - took my contributions.

Vivian Pope called - so did Winnie a second
time.

Barbara Jabra decided to go back - Jeff
Storoy called. Pam took Barbara to the airport.
Marie Vonnecott stepped in. Her sister Majorie
was found dead - by Marie - on the floor.

5th Mon

Slept well.

DATE 5 Jan 1998 (cont)

Snowed last night.

Pam went up to the hospital. When Shirley came back we went by the library to drop off books, to Albertsons for groceries and to post office. There was too long a line. I was going to return a returned bathing suit (I sent it - was returned - company address a little small returned address (mine) was bigger than the company) came home - divided up groceries - I had just time to call re Wilma's (Hirschmann) flight. Half hour late. She feels rugged - flight was difficult on her ears.

Numerous phone calls.

Steven, Shirley and Wanda had a meeting on Ned's finances. When Pam called to say "they" had called in a cardiologist, they - and Wilma - went to the hospital. Dr. Parker, her Primary physician is back in town. Thank goodness they felt so good with him, spelled out Ned's problem: heart failure, pulmonary edema. He agreed - encouraged - hospice care at home. Tell the cardiologist when he came that he wasn't needed. I, too, feel good that he seems to know what's the whole picture is.

6th, Tues

Wilma still a hacking, hard cough.

Hospice moved in a bed. (Pam had cleared things in the computer room.) Pam made me a HEDCOM - the nurse came - morim papers to be signed - Donna Pope brought home in her car. Pam & Shirley were at the hospital - helped her I presume.

Wilma and I stopped for a few groceries. I returned - a pair - my swimming suit.

Heidi Parks came over - back from Virginia for her nephew/wife's car voyage prior to their mission in Tonga. She'd spent the day with her car accident, insurance, etc.

Wilma talked to Lettie and Vivian.

7th, Wed

Wring myself out of bed at 8:00. Exercise.

DATE 7 Jan 1998

Did laundry, answered phone ~~marame~~ times.

Visited Neva several times. ^{She} Slept most of the morning. Meg, the nurse came as did Lesley the nurse aide.

Wilma went to Crossroads Mall for her "lid wipers" — didn't find them at the pharmacist there — never heard of them.

Took car for wash — broken — to Payless for Wilma's lid wipers — none there. Bought a humidifier & puffs a gentle little puff of warm vapor.

^{Harriet} Jacks Rees and Genevieve Cooper visited Neva. The Smiths loaned her their vaporizer.

I went in to visit with Neva while Pam got her some deers — she ate jelly, sweet potato and ?

Principles & Carl Mellor came while she was eating. She went to sleep after they left. Mellors came down to visit with Wilma and me — nice visit.

Gladys is down with "it".

Wilma and I are both beat —
8th, Thurs

Wilma helped me compare Neva's and my pet eyes (wires).

In and out of Neva's. Talked to Winn Call (said Bill wasn't home) re a notary for Neva's power of attorney. Shirley called Bp. Simmons re a notary. Gail Roberts is a notary. Will be at Neva's at 6:00 pm.

Bobby Johnson is to come tonight. Shirley will go back with her for Michael Smith marriage to — ~~marriage~~. I'll spend the night with Neva and Pam.

Gail Roberts is a notary. She took care of Neva's change of power of attorney — from Blevon to Bryan. The Coopers witnessed it (Neva's signature). Bryan and family came. Tina had made a lovely paper(?) flower arrangement.

Spent last night at Neva's. Shirley went to Urem to be there for the night to be ready to attend Michael Smith's ~~wedding~~ this morning. She went to their wedding breakfast. In between Shirley and Wanda Wood went through a temple

In the Am a social worker came. Typical - nice social worker. Wilma and I boxed up most of Neva's bras, slips; moved short clothes - to closet in the computer room. Bagged most of the shoes to clear one side of the closet for Shirley and Pam's clothes, moved her stool - "stained the one" down to my apartment.

Wanda and Jacob Wood brought Shirley back. Wanda stayed until after 6:00 pm - Becky Woodward, Pam's friend, picked her up to take her to Urem for Michael's reception.

Wilma and I still don't have much appetite. - although she said tonight she thought she had a coming appetite.

I came up to Neva's while Pam is at the reception. nice visit with Shirley also - fine young woman.

Joyce Ainsworth brought Neva two beautiful rolls. Diane called. Left Wilma to talk to her as I

came up to Neva's.

10th, Sat.

Wilma coughed all night. I wanted to take her to Innote Care - be there when they opened. She wasn't interested.

Sunday. Waffle for breakfast.

Lettie called to report on Michael Smith's reception. nice surprise.

up to Neva's. She has had a "perky" day.

Wilma and I stopped by FH Library (she dropped me off and waited for me while I went in to copy a couple copies of Neva's living will. Picked three of the Sees chocolate coupons - again Wilma waiting for me. To main public library, then to dry old local place and out to the new Rose Park library to pick up the books they were holding for her. From there to Albertsons. Wilma paid for the groceries. \$42 - awe. Home - beat a 2:30 lunch and a rest.

Gladys didn't go to the U.I. Symposium.

Pam picked up the Aycock - and Barnes, ^{material} after reading Eric Hirschmann's E Mail.

I fell in Neva's apartment. Hewitt my love (left) by Edith Gurnell and Jim McLachlan are feeling better.

DATE 11 Jan 1998

11th Sun

Insoornia at 2:45 pm. Cooked potatoes for salad, also eggs. Read scripture. I've been neglectful. Up at 7:30 - just as soon stayed in bed. Made salad. Shirley Olson and I went to church. Ward Conference. We stayed until after the Bishop's talk. He did well. Well attended Sacrament meeting.

Lunch and a rest. I was tired. Awww.

Wendell Smith took Pam Warner to the airport. Wilma & Keith Fullmer. Wilma gave me a tiny Father Christmas, a bell pin and pictures of her family, Kim and one of her school pictures.

Shirley is picking up her daughter Darla at the airport. (now 8:00 pm) Wilma Hirschmann is playing a computer game. Neva was reading.

12th Mon.

Wilma and I both stayed in bed until about 8:00 AM. Letter & Don Willmore came with two leprosy bandages and a beautiful roast/potatoes/onions/carrots.

I sorted the stacks of material from Neva's - kept out some sheets for Pam Warner and Eric Hirschmann. Changed single bed for Vivian's. She called to say she'd be here about 10:00 pm - daughter, Donna, would meet her. Clive called after 4:00 pm to say she was still in Twin Falls - would be leaving at 5:00 - shall be washed. Snowstorm in Portland delayed bus. Bus company putting on another bus.

Wilma went with me to visit Barbara Causon - she went to Inote Care Saturday - had plenary - gave us a History Farm box (bap sticks, cheese, mustard, also a box of shortbread she'd frosted with chocolate frosting).

Picked up Marie Ward's laundry. Did three batches - the last, just the a real sweat shirt - did not have anything to go with it.

I'm tired - what else is new?

Gledys Burke stopped by - to see Neva & a short visit with Wilma - later with me.

13th Tues

The three of us stayed in bed until around

DATE 13 Jan 1998

8:00 am

Hair cut. Bought some dip mixes for Wilma, Vivian some lozenges. Had car washed.
Dr. appointment with Dr. Lehey. Got a pneumonia shot.

Wilma went with me to return Marie Ward's laundry and officially visit teach.

Vivian stayed with Neva - Wilma went up after we got back from Marie's.

It did not snow as forecast.
14th Wed

Did several loads of bedding of Neva's - Wilma and Vivian went to the Church History and Art Museum. #8 wrote Pat Patten a note to send with the GEDCOM disk requested.

Vivian and Wil went grocery shopping, mailed Pat's disc. Late lunch. Clive Pope came while we were eating. I felt punks.

Wilma reported Neva was weepy. She (Wil) went to Neva with Vivian and Clive. When I went up she was a bit weepy but said she felt so good "in her bosom".

She told Shirley this morning to not do anything with her books until "I'm gone". Under her direction Shirley put "stuff" in a big box for whoever wants items - unwanted items can go to D.D.

Neva talked to Barbara Gardner tonight - I talked to Dr. Lehey's nurse - asked if pneumonia shot had side effects. Sheila made an appointment for me at 4:30 tomorrow.

Talked to Edith Gummell, Gladys Burke and Winnie Mc Lechlan. In for bed early.

Had Phyllis Anisley's (Ensured?) for supper.
15th Thurs

Slept about eleven hours. Breakfast and up to Neva's. Sorted a bit, talked with Neva - arranged for Winnie Mc Lechlan to talk Neva.

Papa and Wilma came about 2:30 - I was resting. They up to see Neva. She was asleep.

Wil made sandwiches for Shirley Olson, Bryan + De

Smith.

They moved Nava's TV in her room -

Shirley cooked the salmon for lunch. It was delicious - looked beautiful too.

Called David - at 2:00 re my IRA distribution. (I can't see any evidence of it on my bank statement.)

Wilma and I visited Chris Muramoto. Sheldon her husband was home also - were eating ~~a~~ delicious smelling bowl of curry and rice. They have two kittens. Raining when we left, snowing as we returned home.

16th, Fri

Wilma and I went to News after breakfast and after a brief visit with her spent a couple hours matching plastic containers and lids, discarding the others; boxing up vases, baskets, etc for Tina Smith.

Shirley Olson picked up Barbara Judson and her daughter, Holly, at the airport. A short rest Wilma, Gladys Banks and I went to Kyoto for lunch. A good one. We sat on mats/floors!

Dropped Gladys off and went to the grocery store - fruit mostly. Via Desert Industries to drop off some things. Crashed when we got home!

Wilma's Fuller came.

17th, Sat

Wilma and I both in bed until 8:00 AM. Very cloudy.

Made custard and Wilma made macaroni and cheese. Took a part of each to Edith Gunnell plus her Christmas gifts.

Stopped at Vossena bakery enroute to Edith's. Wilma went with me. Edith looked better than I expected. (She has had walking pneumonia.)

Lunch of macaroni cheese, salad, hard rolls from Vossena.

Short rest. Kemple and Carl Mellor came. Nava was asleep. Jack Rees had stopped in

to see Neva.

Elaine Crapo brought Winnie McLaughlin to see Neva. Brought her five year old, Emily - beautiful red hair. Neva told Winnie how much her friendships has meant to her. Gave Carl Mallow the little quilted wall hanging - not finished - she wanted him to have.

18th Sun

alarm went off at 7:00 but since I was up from 1:15 - 2:30 AM making curry I didn't get up - a bad habit to get into (ignoring alarm)

Wilma and I went up to Neva's. She was asleep. To church - all three meetings -

I had a good nap. We did the pedigree charts - getting maternal and paternal names in right place. Visited with Neva. She is very weak, lethargic - Von Wannacott visited. Several others tried but she was asleep.

Barbara gave took Wilma's box to the car - took a couple of things to the store - I dumped two bags of stuff in the dumpster.

19th Mon

Wilma left for Austin, TX up at 7:00, Wilma's bags bulging. As we left was snowing/sleetng/blowing. By the time we got to the fairgrounds turned to rain -

Stopped at Albertsons.

Wrote Carol Morgan a note - Visited with Neva, a rest. Darlis cousin, Lori, can't come to SL - snow 4-6" in Ogden. Her dad didn't want her driving. I'm going to use the other opera ticket

Barbara went shopping, had to get out - Steven and his whole family came - Neva was just getting off to sleep - I left when Barbara got back -

Called Eric Hirschmann. Not answering - she ^(Wife) must've missed her Denver flight.

In time before I start to the opera. Was glad to see Steven + family had gone -

Mashed + wife Suzie came just after Steven and family. He thanked me for the Swedish horse I gave them for a wedding present.

DATE 20 Jan 1998

Fres. 20

Slept in until after 8:00 AM - Neva a bit perkier today. Her night shirts located. Found a couple of buffet drawers. Empty'd most of the drawers in the yellow chest of drawers.

Wrote Horace Steels for Neva (E-mail).

Ask Gladys to pick up her car.

Welma Hirschmann called 8:00 pm EST. Had car problems each time she landed.

Call from Felia Carter. Mailed in Trinidad.

Wendell Smith came early evening.

I think I'll go to bed early.

Wrote thank you notes to Welma Fallmer, Edith Bunnell. Thank you notes on Neva's behalf to Mary Cosmans, Della Rees.

Letters from Selma Luster, Ollie Jones. Notes from Milo & Mildred Harper and Glenda Griffith.

Rec'd Mary Anne and handkerchiefs from The Vermont Country Store.

Wed. 21st

after an hour or so of insomnia slept in. Exercised. Wendell Smith called. (He spent the night at Neva's) Lettie called. She and Don will be here next week (M, T, W).

To Neva's. Didn't sleep well. Solbative. Week. Said she had a satisfactory visit with Wendell.

Wrote Barbara Couser and David Harper. Stayed with Neva while Barbara, Holly and Darla went to the mall. Rode with Elaine ^{craps} and Winnie Mc Leckland to Q.C. Jenners. Elaine wanted Neva to see Barbara. Winnie visited Neva briefly.

They bought Neva a lovely night shirt. Holly presented it to Neva - in a pretty silver box with a big pink bow.

Neva told of asking Aline Albrecht if she knew her condition was considered terminal - had a nice visit with Aline - felt her sensitivity which she'd never felt before.

Miriam Pope called. She's torn re their trip to see Gail (daughter) concern for Pyle and Neva.

Date 22 Jan 1998

Thurs. 22nd

Barbara Galie and Holly Story left. Barbara seemed to have a full blown cold.

Wrote David Harper, Delma Carter, Elva Parker. Dale Olson is taking over beautifully. I'm trying not to lounge in too much.

Wanda Wood and her boys came about 5:15pm. Had a good - too long? - nap.

The 8th floor gave Neva a beautiful plant - azalea? Dale Olson gave me a merioure - efficiently - nice Lesley, the aide, came today. Took a few more Hawaii books. Such a pleasant person.

Fri. 23rd

Ann Marie Olson received her endowments today.

Neva experiencing chest pressure. Bryan came about 9:30 am. Nurse (Mae) about 11:00 am. Put a steroid patch on her back. Brought in oxygen.

Did Marie Wark's laundry. Told to Lottie and Julia Carter (enjoyed Spouse Falls) back from her Red Cruise "Boat" her call in three or four days.

Did an E-mail for Wilma Hirschmann with copies to Shirley Olson, Barbara Galie.

Wrote Neva's 8th floor neighbors thanking them for their azalea plant.

Called re my bathing suit. It is enroute. Also called re re squatics class.

Wilma Fullmer came.

Neva vomited twice - better spell. Bryan Smith & Ken Falbig administered to her. Bryan prayed that she would be comforted.

Mae (nurse) will be coming again tomorrow. Puzzeled by the nurse.

I'm worn out. #Wrote E-mail to Wilma H., Shirley O. & Barbara G.

Sat. 24th

Sightish is my usual arising time.

Wilma Fullmer and I went through cleaning items over Neva's washer & dryer. She took some of the things in the closet.

24 Jan 1995

I freshened up towels, wash cloths.

A nap. Laurel Kiebig stopped in. After one foot fissed surgery is now on the mend.

Catherine Thornley called. Doesn't think Julia will 'make it'!

25th, Sun

Wanda & Eric^{Wood} left after I went to church. David, Jimmy Smith and girls came late AM. Stayed 'til 6:30 pm. neva super tired. She ate yogurt and chicken/peanut casserole that David brought from Steafers.

Jim Bonner will be one of the teachers in 'my' S & S class.

She Wannacotts visited neva.

Darce Olson went to church.

Wrote E-mail to Welma Hirschmann with copies to Barbara J. and Shirley Olson - Pam, trust not sure.

26th, Mon Julia Thornley died today. [called Vivian Halverson] [re a let for Julia.]

uneasy night. Exercise

Two loads of laundry. Chicken salad.

Fattie and Don Willmore arrived about 10:30 AM. neva didn't sleep well. Too tired I imagine. Is eating.

Took chicken salad and the roast beef up to neva's for lunch. Darce Olson took a little outing.

Shirley & Preston Olson came. Had a good 'visit' with neva. Dr. Morrill (neighbor) visited too.

Date 26 Jan 1998 (cont)

Came home from Neva's at 7 to find a plastic bag hanging on my door. Beautifully wrapped book and Maxwell's of the Endure St Weil. A note signed "me" — no real clue as who "me" is.

Darla is spending the night with me — Lottie and Don with Neva.

Eric Hirschmann called — to thank me for grand ma Betty Aycock's Book of Mormon. I'm pleased he was pleased.
27th, Tues

Darla slept in. I'm glad. Had to wake her for the nurses visit. Meg (nurse) gave Neva another prescription to assuage her anxiety. Had a business with her Army with Darla.

Lottie, Don & Darla went to the Sort Center. Steven came while the Bishop was still there. Bp. stayed a long time. Steven has been offered a position at Utah Valley State College. Real flight program.

Don saw one of his favorite missionary companions (50 yrs. ago) at the Sort Center. He and his wife are on a mission there.

Went to Russian Mortuary where Julia Carver's great niece's viewing was held. closed casket. Some wonderful pictures of Amy (niece)

28th, Wed
Note from Ann Marie Olson.

Julia Thornley's viewing in Beautiful. The surprise was Riley Moffat's presence. He visited with us as we waited in line. Helen Moffat is in NZ. Helen must've arranged this with Riley before she left for NZ.
Called to Winnie Mc Lachlan. She has a bad case of bronchitis plus a rash.

29th, Wed

Julia Thornley's funeral. Saw the Pat Dalton's & -minded Wilma H., Betty C, Shirley?, Pam and Barbara.
Neva slept late. Was asleep when I went up after the funeral.

Letter from David Harper.

Becky found Neva's birthday book. Hip, hip hooray.

30th, Thu

Neva was still asleep when I went up at 9:00 AM. Brought down the basil. Becky rolled up the egg carton foam and took it to the storage. Brought back my pullover.

So 11:00 AM temple session. Was good to be there. Becky ~~was to~~ ^{was to} leave for Orem about 2:00 PM. (Wilma Fullmer in around 4:00 PM.) Becky went out to her van to find it gone. Was stolen. Spent a good part of afternoon with her, payment impound fee (\$4) and trying to get it out of impound. Couldn't start it. She drove Wilma Fullmer's car to Orem.

Dada and I met Gladys and her sister, Ruth, at the assembly hall for night in Vienna. Delightful evening. I felt almost relaxed when the concert was over.
Neva was awake more today than yesterday.

31st, Sat

Last night was one of my best night's sleep in sometime.
Picked up Ann Marie and Shirley Olson - Dada went with me - at the airport. Plane. Ann Marie looks

Julia Carver and I went to Jerry Lavelle's 70th birthday party. He has sold his apartment, when they take possession he'll be moving to Legacy Retirement Home behind the Jordan River Temple, (next to Chasnutwoods condo complex).

Papas were great. Shrimp, sushi (Jerry's niece Linda made it - tuna fish variety) etc. Jerry's son was there with his wife.

Met Gladys at the symphony. I'm tired before I go. Maybe it will relax me as night in Vienna did last night.

An E-mail from Wend Hirschmann. Papa, Hal & family had been to Hirschmanns. Hirschmanns were invited to Hal & Terry baby's blessing tomorrow.

Rec E-mail also from Pam.

Sun. 1st Feb

To church. Sr. Mein has been assigned to supervise the recording of R.S. I'm to give the tape to the Pumeny president, Marlene Hyde, to pass around to her staff.

Jim Bonner taught the 1st class in Rm. 5 where I attended. Barbara Carson goes for test re a major heart blockage Tuesday.

Hal & Don Roberts' baby was blessed today. Also another baby.

Shirley Olson came for Soc. mtg. We left at 12:15pm. On arriving at Neva's a nurse ? was there. Hal brought more Loripem - Neva seemed very depressed but comfortable. Shirley, Don and Ann Marie sang to her after she relaxed.

Wanda, Bobby, Steven, David, Welva and Keith Fullmer came. When I went down about 4:00 Kerde nee Olson was there.

Neva has been awake most of the day. She was exhausted. Her mind was drifting here and there.

Banana sandwich for supper
made another R.S. tape. # Paul Olson will be using my Grand Theater ticket tomorrow night. Joseph and the Technical Dream cast. Julia Carver declined.

2 Feb 1998

Mon, 2nd

Becky & Danny Johnson spent the night. In an E-mail later this afternoon Becky reported being home. Bob Skimming gave me parking stall 45 for 809. He was very nice.
