I didn't want to get up. Darlene called. She's working

called. They left their phone in my car. I went to Humanitarian
activity, stayed for opening Homemad - an hour - went home
so Darlene (Tina Smith's mother) could get the phone. Was al-
most ready to leave for Penn when Bryan Smith called. Couldn't
get alternator in his car (had stalled last night with tire en-
route to the airport). Waited until he and Darlene got to
the apartment.

22 Shi - visited with Dennis & Carl Mellor. Carl's mother
is having leg problem - strain on Dennis & Carl as she wants
someone with her all the time. Had lunch with them. To
Penn by 4:00 pm.

Visited - Ruth Wilmore brought the children home -
Little went to bed - Don & I visited - ~~the~~

17 Jan 1979

Sun. 17th

Up at 5:15 - shaved, breakfast. Wanda Wool, her boys and Wilma Fullmer. nice ride to Castle Dale. They picked me up at 6:30. Arrived in Castle Dale about 8:45. David Smith and family passed us. Steven Smith and family got lost.

I gave the opening prayer at sacrament meeting - listed as Great Aunt Linda.

Slept soundly until a little after seven. Left Willmoss after 9:00 - stopped at Roma and for gas - home around 11:00. Those tulips and a daffodil are out in the planter - Hyacinth blooming. Propelled it up with a shovel. all except two crocuses are finished.

Wrote Willmoss, Wilma Fullmer, Wanda Wool, Willie Kischmann. Letters from Carol Smith, Wilma Hollings they walked through Paula's house - fine - moved in three cartloads of Paula's "stuff".

Set my navy (new) dress and navy sweater. Don't like the dress. Lottie thought it too big - cloudy / rainy day. cooked country ribs, sweet / white potatoes - legal - scientific? purple.

Tonight is our opera - shall be interesting.

Prained all evening. Of Mice and Men was well staged, impressive lighting, music. Sad but I enjoyed it. I drove Parsons from 95 to 6.

Called to Wanda Wool - the E-mail I sent her. Address seems to be right.

Tues. 19th

Family tape mailed

Slept in - missed the broadcast to Wilma Fullmer on KSL radio, also missed my 9:30 AM appointment with Dr. Labey. Amnes.

Made, mailed family tape.

Gladys ^{Born} got a letter from Sandy & Doug Bars.

Date 30 Jan 1999

Thurs. 11th

Washed a batch laundry including my temple dress.
