

To the Sheriff *of Wayne* County, Greeting:

**W**E command you that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements  
of *Samuel Blythe, Executor of John Safford, late of Wayne Co*  
*decased* (if to be found in your bailiwick) you cause to be made the sum of *Three hundred*  
*and fifty six pounds 12/5 with Interest from October 1782, till paid*  
which was lately in our county court of pleas and quarter-sessions, held for *Wayne*  
county, at the court-house in *Wayneborough*  
adjudged *and recovered against him for Damages by William*  
*Tellon attorney at law for Driven & killed, also the further sum of*  
*Four pounds nineteen shillings & four pence*  
for costs and charges in the said suit expended, whereof the said *Samuel Blythe*  
*Coor* is liable as appears to us of record, and have you the said monies, besides  
your fees for this service, before our said court *Wayneborough*  
aforesaid, on the *second* Monday in *January* next,  
then and there to render the said court *the Damages*

costs and charges aforesaid. Herein fail not, and have you then and there this writ.
